Premium checks are void after 60 days and WILL NOT be reissued

RULES

Exhibitors must abide by the Department of Agriculture’s Health Requirements which may be found at the beginning of the Livestock Department, along with General Rules and Regulations for all Exhibitors.

1. Registration is \$5.00 per head. Registration forms are due to the Fair Office by July 15<sup>th</sup> (4:00 pm) preceding the fair. Late registrations will not be accepted.
2. **Each exhibitor is responsible for lanyard registrations.** Lanyard form links are located on our website <https://cambriacofair.com/> or <https://sites.google.com/view/american-legion-co-fair/home> If you have any problems accessing these sites please email us at [ccfair@verizon.net](mailto:ccfair@verizon.net).
  - Lanyard registrations submitted after July 15<sup>th</sup> will not be accepted. Exhibitor Lanyards are \$10 and Family Lanyards are \$20 each.
  - **LANYARD DISTRIBUTION:** The registration now has payment enabled online and is required during the order process. Pick up will be at the fair office Saturday August 17<sup>th</sup> 12 to 2 pm. or Aug. 19 - 23 Monday thru Friday 9 to 4 pm. **Lanyards will not be available Livestock check-in day.**
3. All Goats must be USDA tagged or USDA tattooed as recognized in an approved USDA Scrapie database.
4. This identification must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) completed within 30-days of check-in the health certificate.
5. Exhibitors must produce a breed certificate for any goats that are being shown as purebreds.
6. Each exhibitor showing Dairy and/or Meat Breeding Goats is limited to 6 goats total across the board including the maximum of 2 Market Goats. All goats must be owned and in your possession by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
7. **All grooming and fitting must occur in the Goat barn no exceptions. No goats are allowed at the campers and are only permitted to exercise in the show tent.** A light touch up consisting of a brush may be used preceding and during the show. Goats are only permitted to be washed in the goat barn or beef barn when the goat barn is full.
8. **The exhibitor is responsible for completing the grooming and fitting of their project animal.** Only family members and their Cambria County 4H leaders may assist by direction only. All fitting and animal preparation must be done in an ethical manner. No unethical practices will be tolerated before, during, or after the show i.e. : slapping/hitting animals, suspending animals off sheering stands, ice or frozen blankets, show shake drenching, injections of any substance orally or in the body (without prior authorization of the Fair’s veterinarian and barn superintendent), suspending feet off the ground, and pronged collars.

- 9. **DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS:**
  - Goat Stands/Show Boxes are to be kept in storage areas designated by the barn superintendents during fair week.
  - Stands/Boxes are allowed in the main aisle the night prior and the day of the show.
  - Stands/Boxes must be stored **promptly** after the show.
- 10. No Pronged Show Halters or Collars will be permitted. There will be NO WARNING FOR THIS RULE – ANY VIOLATORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- 11. Exhibitors cannot show dairy and/or meat breeding goats in more than one County Fair.
- 12. Minimum weight 60 pounds; maximum weight 125 pounds.
- 13. All decorations must be put on the back wall or attached to the steel wire where supplied. No decorations, awards or ribbons may be put on the stall or doors for the animal’s safety.
- 14. When in the show ring, ALL 4 feet of the goat MUST be on the ground when displaying animal for judging. Exhibitors will be reminded of this rule prior to the show. Show stewards will monitor this and any violators will be disqualified. Eligibility to sell the animal will be at the discretion of the Youth Livestock Sale Committee.
- 15. Market/ Meet Breeding goats need to be off their show stands and ready to show by the time Dairy Showmanship ends.
- 16. **Exhibitors are not allowed to be coached in the show ring by anyone in attendance.**

**Rules**

1. Weight Classes will be determined Check-in Day.
2. Champions and reserve champions of weight classes will receive rosettes. Grand and Reserve Champions will receive banners.
3. **IMPORTANT SALE INFORMATION** - Market animals may be sold during the Youth Livestock Sale. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion animals **MUST** be sold at the sale. **Exhibitor MUST be on time and present in the sale ring when their animal is scheduled for sale. Those that are not, will be sold through the BuyBack program. Exhibitor MUST take sale paperwork to their buyer for signature to complete the transaction.** Therefore, families **MUST** have a parent/sibling/friend present at ringside to hold the animal while this is done. **Exhibitors MUST care for their market animals through load out on Saturday afternoon.** This includes proper feed/water, pen maintenance and washing any fitting products off the animals.

**Rules**

1. If you wish to show in the County Bred market class, you are required to fill out the registration form in its entirety. A breeder signature is required either on the registration form or on a signed copy of a sales receipt. Sales receipt must describe the animal as a "Cambria County Bred Market Goat" and have a tag number as a reference. A "Cambria County Bred Market Goat" must meet all the County Bred requirements. The requirements are: the animal must be born from a female that is owned by a Cambria County resident that has taken the responsibility to breed the female and for that female to bear offspring while in their possession in Cambria County and that offspring be raised in Cambria County. Cambria County Breeder signature, address, phone number is required, e-mail is optional.
2. The County Bred Form must be turned in with Entry Form.
3. COUNTY BRED SHOW - the top 2 placed goats in the market classes will return for the county bred show. Grand champion and reserve champion in the market show are not eligible to enter. Grand and Reserve Champions will receive banners.
