

Do not tell me that a man's heart is right with God when his head contains a creed of error and denies the Person and work of the Redeemer. —Horatius Bonar

"He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him."—John 3:36

In this verse we see that the main evidence of salvation, of having eternal life, is God-given faith in Christ, the Son of God, whose name is "Jesus, for He shall save His people from their sins" (Matt. 1:21). His name is "Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us" (Matt. 1:23). His name is "the LORD our righteousness" (Jer. 23:5; 33:16), as it is by His obedience unto death as our Surety, Substitute, and Redeemer, that all of God's elect shall be saved and brought to faith in Him and repentance of dead works and idolatry. Such are sinners saved eternally by God's grace in Christ.

The main evidence of being condemned under God's wrath is unbelief of Christ in the glory of His Person and power of His finished work of righteousness. Such are sinners who "shall not see life." They will live in unbelief, die in unbelief, and spend eternity separated from God.

You may ask, "Is there any hope, then, for me?" Consider – Are you a sinner? Yes! God's Word says that God sent His Son into the world to save sinners. How does God save sinners? He saves them by His grace through the blood and righteousness of the Lord Jesus Christ. He brings them in power to believe and rest in Christ for all salvation with all the blessings and benefits of eternal life. Do you believe on the Son of God Who, by Himself, fulfilled all the conditions of your salvation? Do you know that you have no righteousness to plead before God but Christ's righteousness imputed and which you have received by God-given faith? Do you admit that if God were to judge you based on your best and most sincere efforts you would be condemned forever? If you do, you are God's "workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them" (Eph. 2:10). —Pastor Bill Parker
