He is the Alpha and the Omega of the Bible, from the first verse in Genesis, to the last verse in Revelation. Oh, study the Scriptures of truth with a view of learning Christ. Do not study the Bible as a mere history. Do not read it as a mere poem. Do not search it as a book of science. It is all that, but infinitely more. The Bible is the Book of Jesus! It is a revelation of Christ! Christ is the golden thread which runs through the whole!

Blessed Lord Jesus! I will read and study and dig into the Scriptures to find and learn more of You! You, Immanuel, are the fragrance of this divine box of precious ointment. Things That Are Freely Giving

"Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God." (1 Corinthians 2:12)

Man by nature believes that salvation must be bought, earned, or, at least, believed by him in order to be effectual. Because of natural pride and self-righteousness, he must find a condition that he can meet in order to attain or maintain salvation or some part of it. But this is not so! (unregenerate) man cannot buy or earn salvation, and, by nature, he does not want it and will not believe it - "But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned" (1 Cor. 2:14). This is why it takes the power and work of the Holy Spirit for us to know and receive the salvation that God has worked out and provided for us in and by the Lord Jesus Christ. The Spirit reveals and convinces of "the things that are **FREELY given to us of God"** based on the obedience unto death of the Lord Jesus Christ as our Surety, Substitute, and Redeemer. And what are these "things that are freely given"? They are ALL OF SALVATION, every blessing and benefit of salvation, by God's grace in Christ and based on His righteousness freely imputed to us and His life freely given to us of God. Even the faith that spiritually unites us to Christ is freely given to us of God (John 1:12-13; Eph. 2:8-10). The repentance that brings us to turn away from sin and self is freely given to us of God (Acts 5:31; 2 Tim. 2:25). The perseverance by which believers continue unto glory is freely given to us of God (Eph. 1:13-14; Jude 24-25). "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath blessed us with ALL SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS in heavenly places in Christ" (Eph. 1:3), and all of these blessings are freely given to us of God in and by the Lord Jesus Christ. —Pastor Bill Parker
