Who Are the Real Antinomians?

An antinomian is one who is against the law of God. Just about every true Gospel preacher and believer has been accused by legalist of being antinomians. The reason is that we who believe the true Gospel of God's free and sovereign grace in and by the Lord Jesus Christ claim from the Scriptures that "we are not under the law, but under grace" (Rom. 6:15), and we "stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage" (Gal. 5:1). But, contrary to what the legalists accuse us, not being under the law and standing fast in our liberty in Christ gives us no license to sin or to lead ungodly lives. Though it is true that we are not under the Old Covenant law of Moses, this does not mean that we have no words of guidance and obedience from the Lord in His Word which we are commanded to obey. This obedience is necessary but not as conditions by which we merit or earn salvation, blessings, and rewards from God. That is legalism, and it is a denial of the Gospel of God's grace and the righteousness of God which is freely given and imputed to us without our works of the law (Rom. 3:21-31; 4:1-8). The real antinomians are those who use the law of God as a means of earning God's favor and blessings. They think that by their efforts to keep the law, they can measure up enough to stop sinning enough to be righteous in themselves and win God's favor and blessings. In reality, they are breaking and ignoring the law which says flee to Christ for all righteousness and obey Him as motivated by love and grace, not law (Rom. 10:4)! -Pastor Bill Parker
