Financial Status:


The Financial Report from Sandhills Accounting Services for June 2022 showed Year-to-Date contributions were \$97.76 over budget needs and Year-to-Date expenses were under budget by \$26,292.95. For the month of June, contributions were \$1,233.55 over the budgeted needs while expenses continue to be under budget, this month by \$2,644.31.

As far as investments, Culdee's funds are invested with minimal risk as recommended by Stifel for non-profit organizations. While investments accounts are moving up and down almost hourly as the market changes, there has been no actual loss and there won't be unless Culdee is forced to tap into those funds immediately. Fortunately, these investments are for long-term, like the Sarah Ann Fortune Fund and Parking Lot Fund, and aren't immediately needed.

The interest rates on CDs have increased to the extent that Culdee was advised by Live Oak Bank that if current CDs earning less than 1% were cashed in early and new CDs taken out at the new rate of 2.20%, earnings would be significantly higher, even with the early withdrawal penalty. After discussion and reviewing the figures, the Finance Ministry has made the changes with the CDs and is now earning 2.20% on the Live Oak Bank CDs.
