

## Map Activity

Alexander Campbell lived in Bethany, Virginia. In 1863, during the Civil War, it became West Virginia. Barton W. Stone preached at the Cane Ridge Meeting House near Paris, Kentucky. Use the map below to do the following activities:

- In which state do you live? Find your approximate location and mark it with a big red X.
- Find West Virginia and color it pink.
- Find Kentucky and color it green.
- Circle the dots for Bethany, West Virginia, and Cane Ridge, Ky.
- Draw lines between your big red X and Bethany and Cane Ridge.
- Using the more detailed maps, locate and mark Bethany and Cane Ridge.
- Trace a portion of the Ohio River that runs between Ohio and West Virginia.
- In a bright color, trace major highways leading to Bethany and Cane Ridge.
- Use a United States atlas and find Bethany and Cane Ridge. Can't find them? Look for Wheeling and Lexington.
