Prayers at Panera: Caring for those outside our church walls

When I began my Prayers at Panera ministry, I had no idea what to expect. Would people come? Would people be comfortable asking a stranger to pray with and for them? These are some of the questions that ran through my mind at the start of this ministry in September. All I knew is that I felt compelled to try this third space type of ministry and Pastor Krebill graciously allowed me to experience this as a part of my internship here at Bethel.

What I did not expect was the outpouring of love, prayers and support from the members at Bethel. It quickly became apparent that you were just as excited about this ministry as I was by your checking in with me each week to see how this new ministry was going as well as stopping by during the prayer time at Panera for your own prayer needs and pastoral care.

As I look back over the past three months of this ministry, it has been reinforced that people everywhere long to know that God still cares about them beyond their relationship with the institutional church. I sat with people who were hurt by the church they loved and made to feel unworthy and in some cases carried bitterness toward the church. I sat with people who wanted to feel God's presence as they awaited an appointment with their doctor to get test results, because they are fearful of what they might hear. Others just wanted a safe place to unburden themselves and know that someone in this world is willing to let them do that, no strings attached. Perhaps the most moving visit I had was with a couple, who were homeless, who wandered into Panera to get warm on a chilly day. They sat down at the table next to me trying to warm their hands as they shared a cup of hot water because they could not afford to buy anything. I reached into my bag where I kept a supply of Panera gift cards that were generously donated for this ministry, in case someone was in need of a meal, and pulled out \$20 worth of gift cards and offered them to the couple. They were overwhelmed by my gesture and told me they had not had a hot meal in two days. Once they had eaten their fill, we quickly struck up a conversation. They shared their life's story with me about how once they had it all, a lovely home, their children went to private school, they had two beautiful cars in the driveway but because of a couple bad decisions in the stock market and medical expenses, they lost all their possessions and were too embarrassed to tell their children. We must have talked for nearly an hour as they shared their story. We prayed together, we cried together over their loss and fears. I provided them names and locations of agencies that might be able to assist them. There was nothing more I could do for them and yet, they were overjoyed just to be fed and cared for. Something we often take for granted.

There is a part of me that is going to miss my Wednesday mornings at Panera, meeting people where they are at. It has reminded me that people everywhere are in need of hearing they are loved, loved by God and loved by their neighbor. The amazing, lavish love that God gives us is not meant to be kept within the confines of our church walls, our homes, our automobiles... it is meant to be shared with the world outside the walls that separate us.
