Beyond Biscuits

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." - Matthew 5:4

Brian Perry works at KPRC. He and his wife, Angie, were overjoyed when they had their son, Ethan. At age 12, Ethan was diagnosed with T-cell lymphoblastic Lymphoma. For the next many months, Ethan endured many, many treatments. For a time, there was hope but when Ethan's condition deteriorated so much, Ethan made the brave decision to go home. He hadn't even reached his 13th birthday.

Before the trauma of cancer, the Perry family ate breakfast every Saturday at their local Chick-Fil-A. The family got breakfast biscuits and always sat at table 13 so they could see the sun.

Several weeks after Ethan's passing, Brian got up on a Saturday morning and decided to go to Chick-Fil-A. He ordered two biscuits, one for him and one for Ethan. Through tears he wasn't sure if he ate them or not.

After word got out about the family's loss, Brian went back to their Chick-Fil-A on a Saturday morning and there was a Reserved sign on table 13, as there would be every Saturday from then on. That is the power of a caring community.

Every March, the month of Ethan's passing, Brian and Angie take a trip to remember him. The director at their Chick-Fil-A made arrangements for them to visit CFA headquarters in Atlanta. When they got there they were greeted by a man named Ed Perry. 'Ed Perry?' they thought. 'He and Ethan have the same initials- EP- and everyone called him 'EP.' Ethan did this!' Of course, there were chicken breakfast biscuits waiting for them. The power of love can be quite strong in the face of loss.

The word 'restaurant' means 'to restore.' Sometimes a biscuit is more than a biscuit, especially in the hands of Christ-followers. Sometimes Church can be outside its walls; Right inside MD Anderson Cancer Center there is a Chick-Fil-A. It became a place of peace and comfort for the Perry family.

God works in every detail of our lives—even flour and water. Never underestimate the power of little things to bring comfort and hope. You never know when a caring word—or a simple 'Reserved' sign---can bring comfort.


The weekend of April 26 – 28 the Troop attended Full Throttle Weekend at Camp Strake near Coldspring.
