Dear Parishioners

We the Sts. Peter and Paul Quilters are asking for your help. **WE NEED QUILTERS!!!**

As many of you know we make quilts for the activities that take place at our church such as; the Bazaar, and the fish fries each year we also make a youth quilt for the Bazaar. Along with other people they bring us their quilt tops and we quilt them. In 2018 we entered one of our quilts at the Howard County Fair. We received "Best in Show" and a 1st place ribbon. Our quilt was displayed at the Nebraska State Fair in the quilters building and received a 1st place blue ribbon.

We have 13 quilts to get quilted as of right now. We have 6 ladies that are able to quilt at the frame and 2 ladies who work at a hoop, as it is more comfortable for them. Over the years we've had as many as 10 quilters now we are down to 6 that are working on the frame. The last quilt we did was a HUGE king size, it took us 4 months to quilt. Of course people get sick or have other things to do, so we do the best we can right now, but we may not be able to do a youth quilt or fish fry in the future.

We welcome everyone any age or skill level, if you cannot quilt or you would like to learn we have teachers that would love to teach you. Please consider coming Tuesdays from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. just three hours a week. If you are unable to attend Tuesday from 1-4 we are willing to teach after hours.

The money we make all goes to the church. Since 2007 we have put our money into a savings account and give once a year donation. Over the years we've been keeping track and we have given the church over \$12,700. The twelve thousand doesn't include what the bazaar and youth quilt bring in which is between \$860.00 and \$1109.00 each year.
