ORDINANCE NO. O-13-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §10-1 OF THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL REGARDING
PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell seeks to recognize Martin Luther King, Jr. Day as a holiday in the Borough starting in the year 2020; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. §10-1. List of public holidays established, shall be amended to provide the following:

The following twelve (12) days shall be treated and considered public holidays:

- (1) New Year's Day.
 - (2) Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
 - (3) President's Day.
 - (4) Good Friday.
 - (5) Memorial Day.
 - (6) Independence Day.
 - (7) Labor Day.
 - (8) Columbus Day.
 - (9) Veterans Day.
 - (10) Thanksgiving Day.
 - (11) Day after Thanksgiving.
 - (12) Christmas Day.
2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
 3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
