

BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL
ORDINANCE NO. O-9-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE X
(MUNICIPAL COURT) OF THE BOROUGH OF
NORTH CALDWELL TO PROVIDE FOR THE
APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL COURT
JUDGES

WHEREAS, Chapter 3-40 of the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell provides for the creation of a Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell deems it advisable to authorize the Mayor of the Borough of North Caldwell to appoint one or more Municipal Court Judges to preside over said Court; and

WHEREAS, The Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell deems it be desirable to amend the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell to provide for the appointment of one or more Municipal Court Judges by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council provided that only one such Judge shall be designated to receive a salary, benefits or other contributions paid by the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Article X, Municipal Court, of the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell be and is hereby amended to provide the following:

§3-40. Creation of Municipal Court; Seal.

The Municipal Court of the Borough of North Caldwell in the County of Essex is created and established, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-4, with all the functions, powers, duties, privileges and jurisdiction now or hereafter conferred by law. Said Court shall have a seal which shall bear the impression of the name of the Court.

§3-41. Appointment of Municipal Court Judges; Term of Office; Compensation.

A. One or more Judges duly appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council shall preside over the Municipal Court. The Judges so appointed shall have the qualifications required by law and shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years and until their successor is appointed and qualified.

B. In the event more than one Municipal Court Judge is appointed, only one of them shall be designated to receive a salary, benefits or any other contributions paid by the Borough. The annual compensation for the Municipal Court Judge shall be fixed and determined in the Borough Salary Ordinance and shall be in lieu of any and all other fees.

§3-42. Appointment of Municipal Court Clerk and Violations Clerk; Salary.


There shall be appointed annually a Municipal Court Clerk and Violations Clerk. The salary of said Municipal Court Clerk and Violations Clerk shall be fixed in the annual Salary Ordinance of the Borough.

2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
