

**BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL
ORDINANCE NO. O-9-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 45
AND 104 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH
OF NORTH CALDWELL REGARDING FEES**

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator has recommended certain changes in the fee schedule of the Borough of North Caldwell to more closely reflect the actual cost to the Borough for the issuance of certain licenses and the provision of certain specialized products and services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator has recommended certain changes in the criteria for waiver of water and sewer surcharges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Chapter 45-1 of the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell, *Rates and Fees*, be and is hereby amended as follows:

- a. Fee Schedule - Installation of water meters, by meter size (in inches), shall be amended to read as follows:

1 1/2	\$1,500
2	\$1,800

- b. Sewer - the final sentence which states,

"In the discretion of the Borough Administrator, for good cause, said surcharge, in an amount not to exceed \$100.00; may be waived on one occasion for any given sewer account. (Ordinance No. 13-2016)" shall be deleted.

2. Chapter 45-2 shall be added to Chapter 45 of the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell and shall provide that,

"In the discretion of the Borough Administrator, and for good cause shown in accordance with the "Policy for the Waiver of Penalties and Surcharges for Late Water and Sewer Payments", approved from time to time by the Governing Body of the Borough, the Borough Administrator may waive the payment of penalties or surcharges for any given water or sewer account."

3. Chapter 104-6 of the Code of the Borough of North Caldwell, *Water Bills; when payable; effect of nonpayment*, be and is hereby amended as follows:

The final sentence of §104-6B, which states,

"In the discretion of the Borough Administrator, for good cause, said surcharge, in an amount not to exceed \$100.00, may be waived on one occasion for any given water account. (Ord. No. 13-2016)" shall be deleted.

4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.


