The end of 2024 is fast approaching! Time is flying! November began with each of us voting in a national election and ended with a Friendsgiving for the youth at Messiah and a joint Thanksgiving Eve service held at Messiah. Bethany participated in the Burlington Holiday Parade to kick off the holiday season. The church year is unique in that a new liturgical year begins as the calendar year ends. Soon churches and houses will be decorated for the holiday season!

We have a lot going on at Bethany and Messiah! Advent begins December 1! Both churches will have the hanging of the greens that day. Bethany in the afternoon and Messiah right after church. It is a wonderful time to come together in a festive way while making the churches beautiful for Advent and Christmas.

We will have joint midweek Advent services held at Bethany. There will be a meal at 6pm and a vesper service at 7pm. This year we will use a new service from Holden Village called Bless This Night. It is a beautiful service that highlights the sacredness of night and darkness.

New this year is a joint Blue Christmas Service that will take place at 6pm on December 19th at Unity Lutheran Church. I am working with Pastor Cosgrove on this service. Blue Christmas is a service for individuals who need a gentle service for the holidays – a place where they don't have to ignore their grief, sadness, or loneliness. Christmas can be hard for some people and a Blue Christmas service is a place where they can be themselves without any judgement.

Christmas Eve is full of services – 3 to be exact! The early service will be at 5pm at Bethany. The evening service will be at 7pm at Messiah and the night service will be at 11pm at Messiah. You are welcome to attend the service that suits your needs.

December 29th will be a hymn sing. Start taking time now to look through the hymnal (the ELW) to find your favorite hymns! The hymns sung on 29th will come from the congregation. There will be communion on this Sunday and lots and lots of hymns!

Confirmation is going well! We are in the middle of the commandments. As part of our learning we will have two special services led by the confirmation students. A confession and forgiveness service and a service of healing. The service of healing will take place in February. The confession and forgiveness service will take place Thursday, January 16, 2025 at 7pm at Messiah Lutheran Church. It is important to support the youth of our congregations, so we hope to see you all there!

There are more families moving to this area from Ukraine and also from other countries where violence and hardship are prevalent, such as Haiti and Venezuela. World Relief, based in the Quad Cities, helps them and they rely on donations to outfit a home. The families often arrive with only a few items of clothing. If you have any spare furniture you would like to donate, they would be very welcome for other families. If you let me know, I can arrange for pickup.

Small items are also needed--especially bath towels, dishes, glasses, mugs, silverware, and other kitchen items, and sheet/blanket sets. Thank you so much for so clearly modeling Christ's love for these good people! -Kim Engle

December 29 will be a Hymn Sing! Hymns will come from the congregation, so get your favorite Hymns ready from the ELW to shout out!


Wendy will be out of the office on Monday, December 9. The office will be closed.
