The very first day of December is the start of Advent, which is the beginning of the church year! We will decorate the churches and wait in anticipation for the coming Christ child. This year we will have joint midweek Advent services held at Bethany. A meal will be served at 6pm and a vesper service will begin at 7pm. Our Christmas Eve services will occur at 5pm at Bethany and at 7pm and 11pm at Messiah.
