I have lived in Burlington and been your pastor for four months now! What a wonderful four months it has been indeed! I have met many new people and experienced lots of new things. There is so much to see and do in Burlington and the surrounding towns. I have explored restaurants and museums. I love walking on the trails in the park and along the river. Remembering the wonder times had in New Orleans during the Youth Gathering. Being a plenary speaker at the Conference of Worship, Theology, and the Arts at St. Olaf College. My first blessing of backpacks and my first Affirmation of Baptism. So many firsts!

I started an eight-week program called the Burlington Citizens Fire Academy. It is a wonderful program operated by the Burlington Fire Department. They put a great deal of time, energy, and effort into providing hands on opportunities for citizens to gain a better understanding of what it is like to be a firefighter in general and a Burlington firefighter in particular. The Burlington Fire Department is amazing! They handle hundreds of calls a month, go into burning buildings to rescue people, put out dangerous fires, attend to chemical spills, and many other dangerous scenarios. They protect the citizens of Burlington and the surrounding communities including crossing the river into Illinois.

By participating in this program, I have had the opportunity to drive both a fire truck and an ambulance. I have operated the spreaders and cutters (known by many as the jaws of life). I have been able to try my hand at (using training objects) intubation and placing an iv in a bone. I rappelled down the side of the fire station and I was 102 feet in the air in the bucket of the ladder truck. On September 16 we were recognized at the City Council Meeting. I earned a certificate and two collectible coins from the Burlington Fire Department. I have learned so much, made many new friends and connections. I continue to pray for the safety of our Burlington firefighters.

I have participated in several synod events during these first few months of my time with you. I attended Synod Assembly and was elected as a voting member to Churchwide Assembly. I participated in Narrative Budget training. I went to the New to the Synod Event at the Synod Office and recently returned from the Rostered Ministers Fall Gathering in Coralville. In November I will have boundary training in Muscatine and an Evening of Gratitude in Bettendorf hosted by the Synod Office.

Now that fall is finally here, I'm ready for all things pumpkin spice! Confirmation is also underway. Preparation is beginning for our fall and winter services – Reformation Sunday, All Saints Sunday, Thanksgiving Eve, midweek Advent services, and Christmas Eve! I love this time of year! I can't wait to make memories with each of you as we continue to journey together as I serve Bethany and Messiah.
