Print your name on this shirt and draw symbols that show you belong to God.

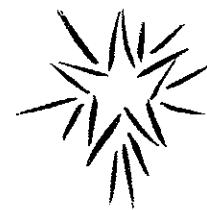


This week

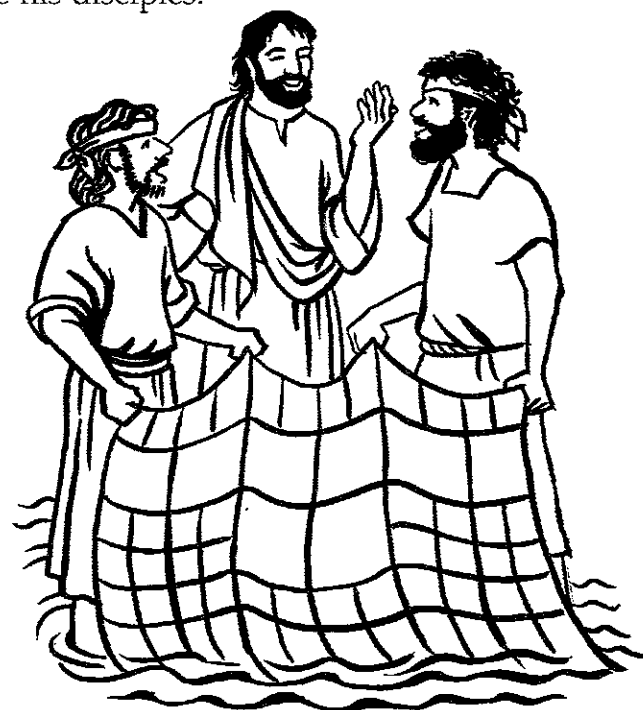
Third Sunday after Epiphany

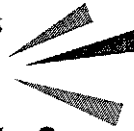
What season is it where you live? Winter or summer? God's people live in all parts of the world. **Find the globe in the picture and draw the Northern Hemisphere.**

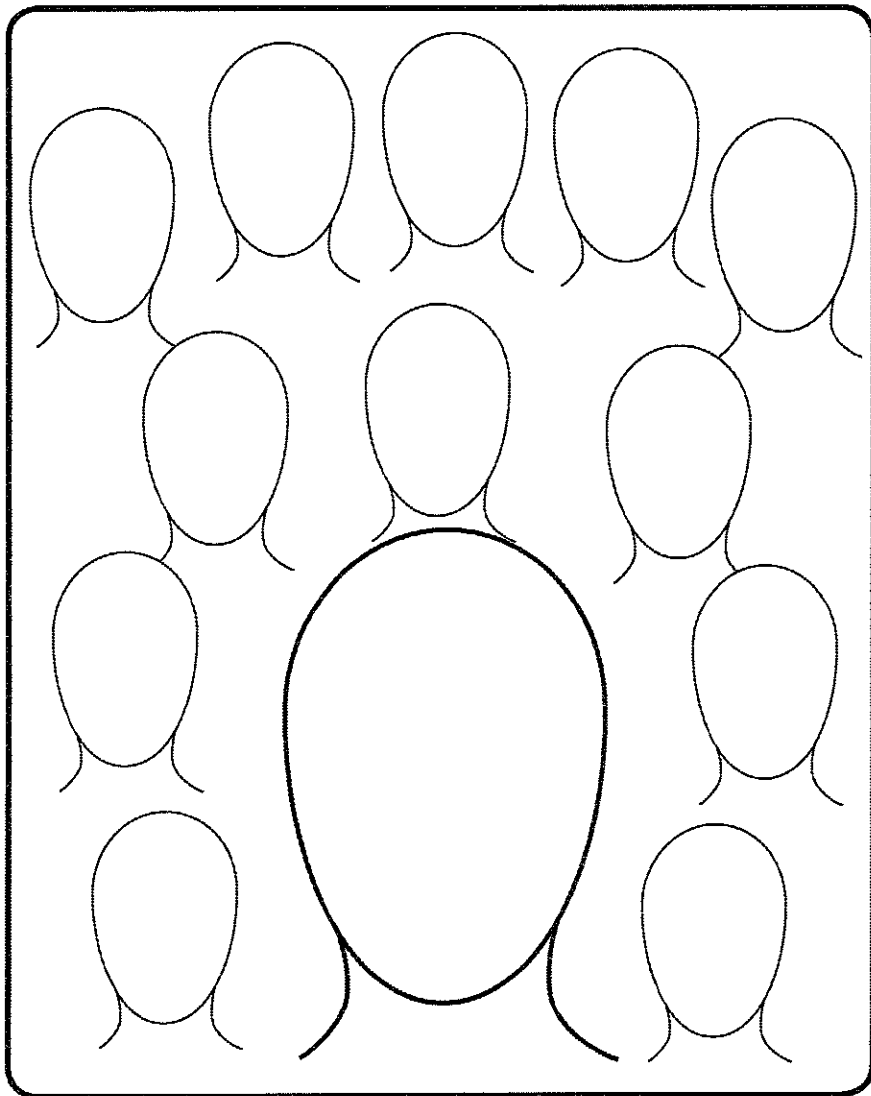

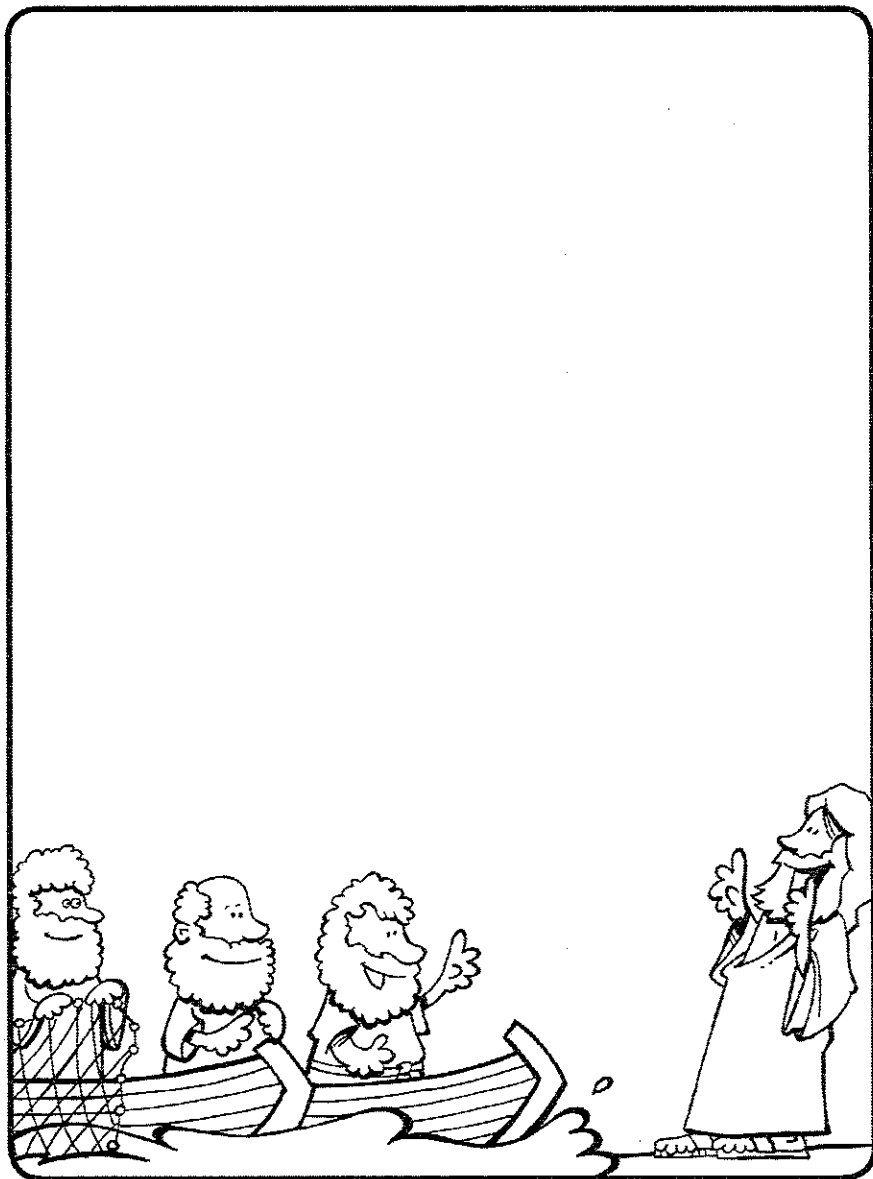

Use green and other bright colors to color these Epiphany flowers!

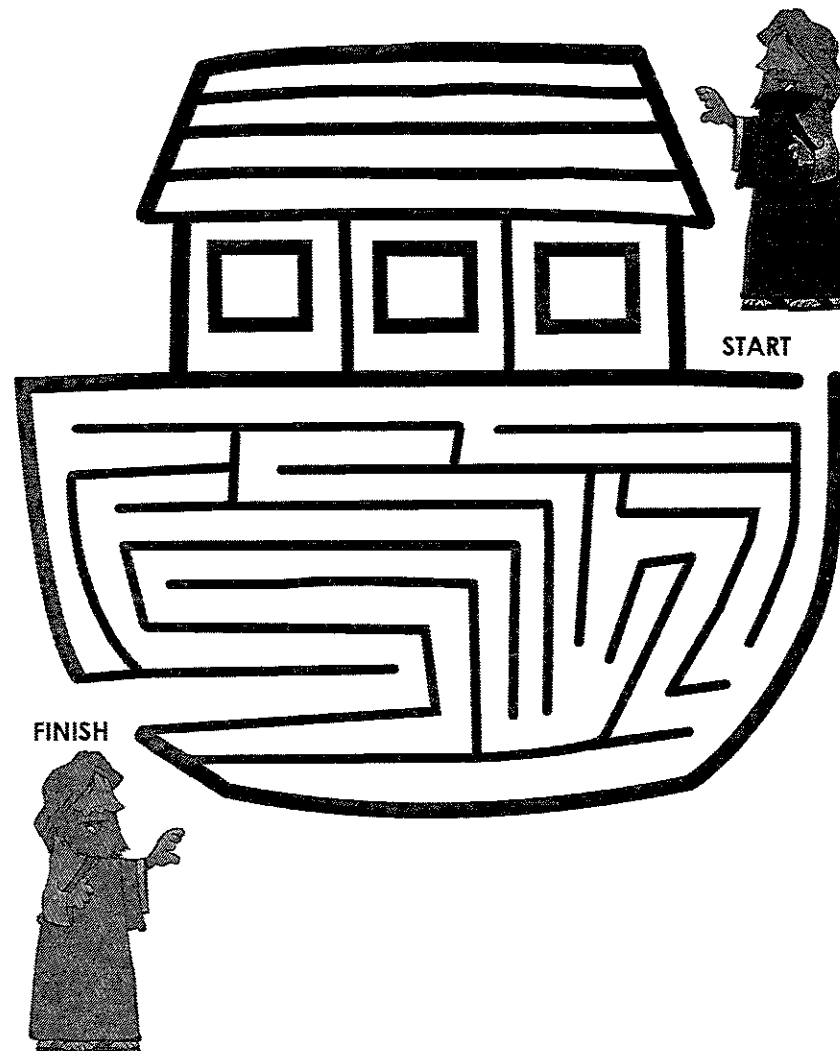

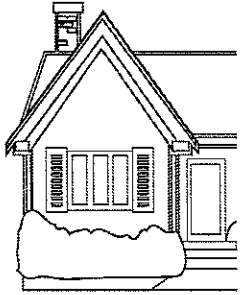
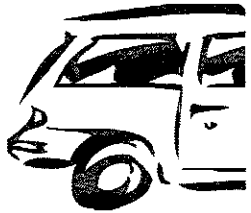
Jesus met some of his disciples while they were fishing in boats.
