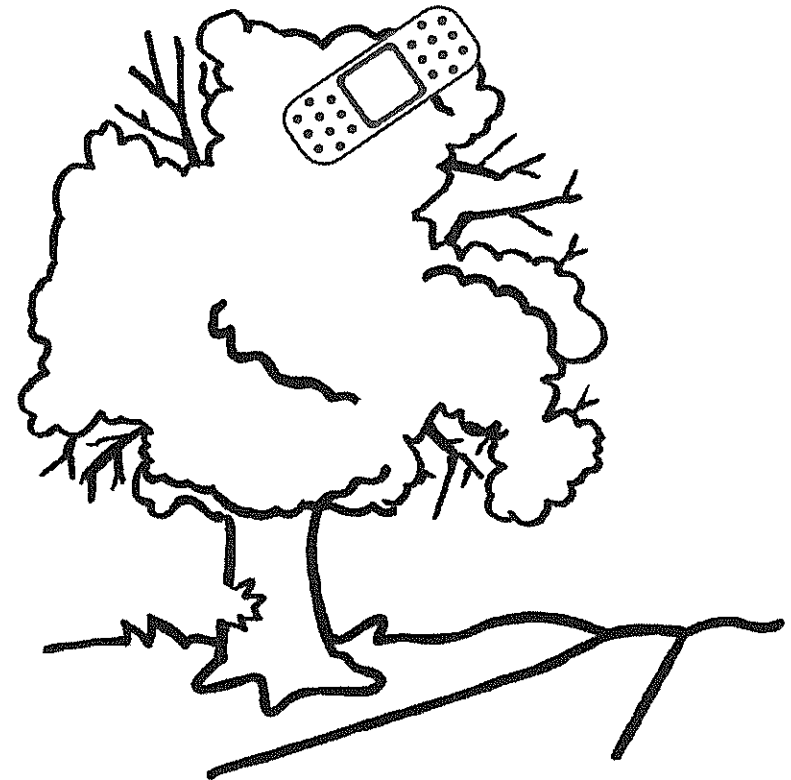

the tree.



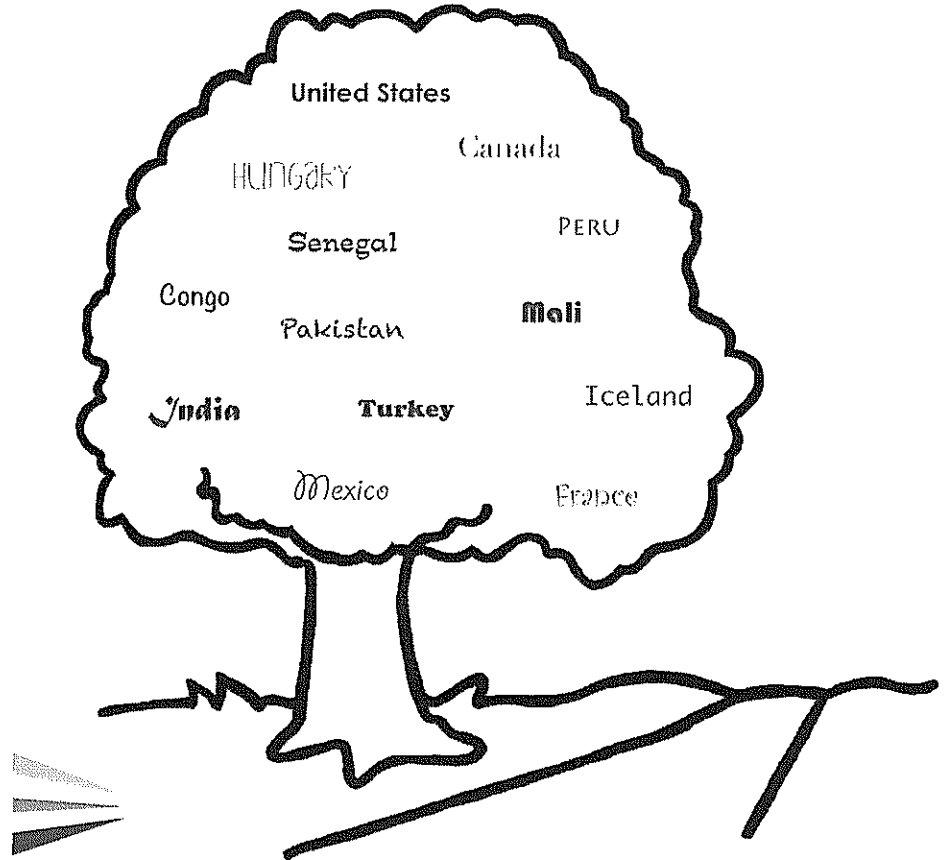

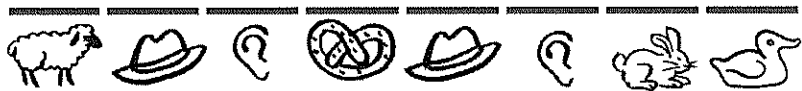
