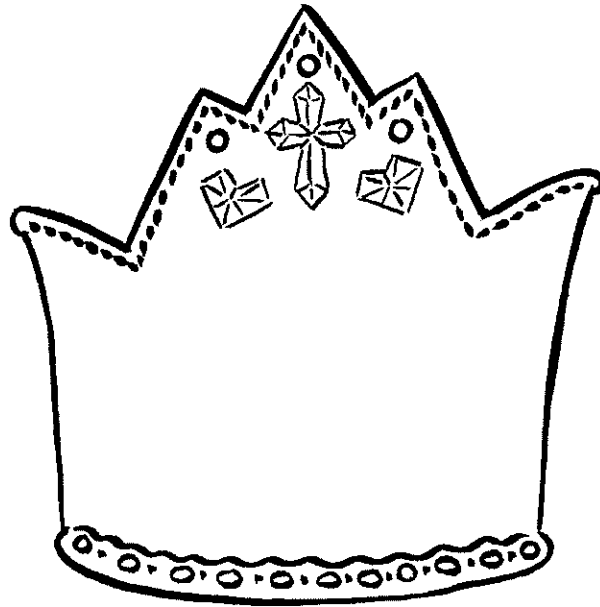

What picture can you draw in this crown that shows God's kingdom?

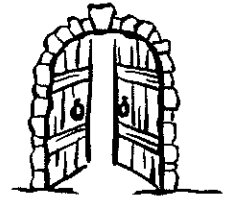

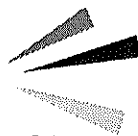

Do you see a cross at your church? The cross reminds us of Jesus. Color these crosses. Then draw a cross in the space.

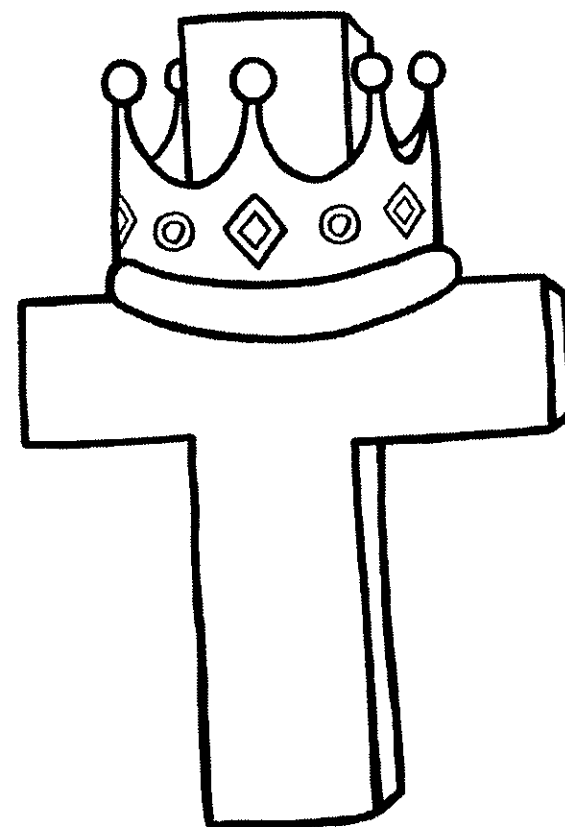
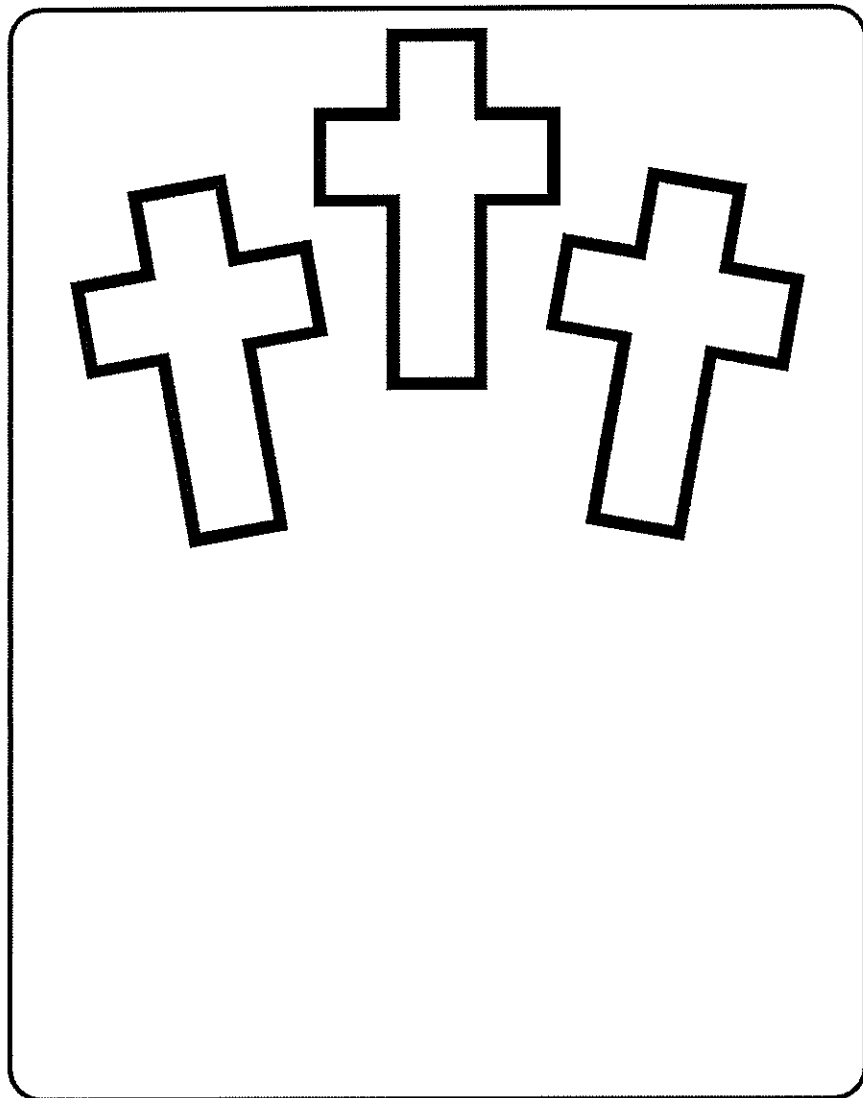

Jesus is our shepherd who leads us. We are the sheep.

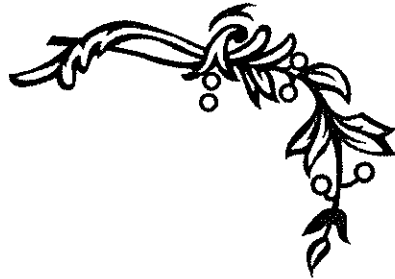
Sometimes the sheep get lost. We can help Jesus find the sheep. Can you find the three SHEEP in this word find?

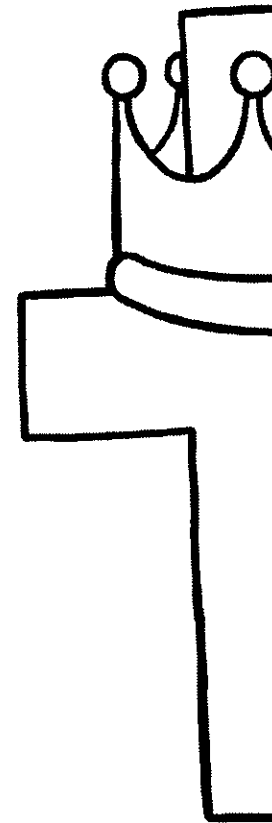

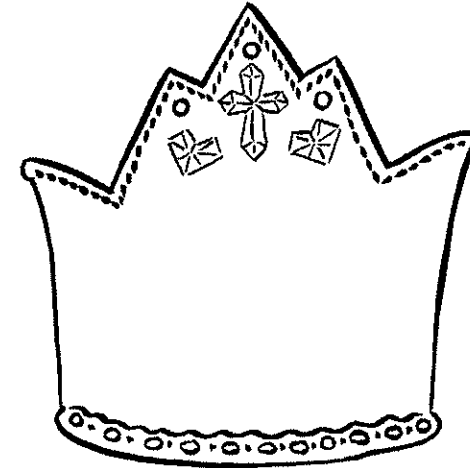
