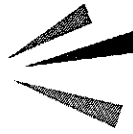
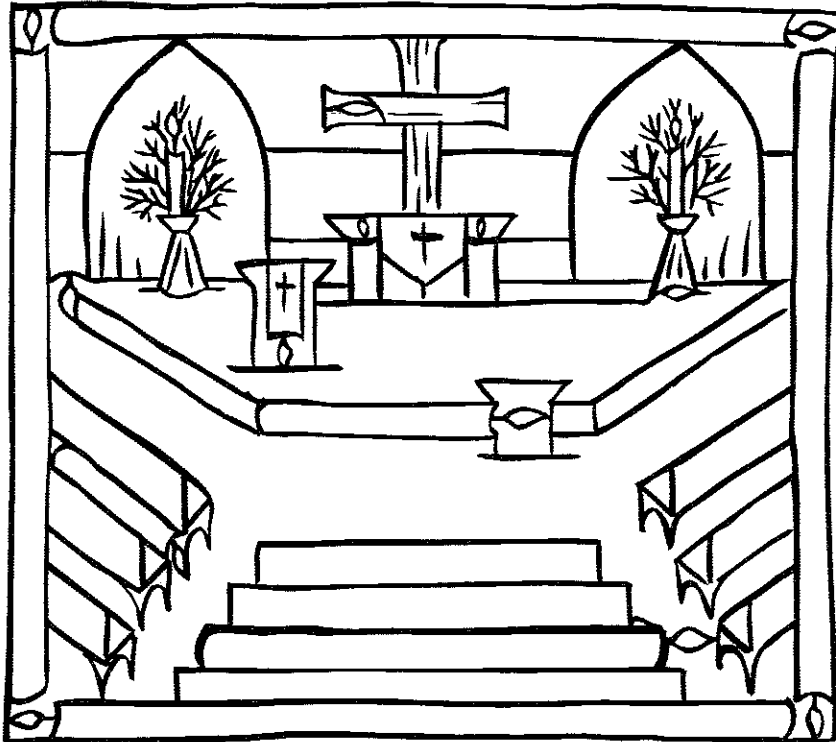


Many churches have a cross or a candle in their worship space to remind them of Jesus. Look around. Do you see crosses or candles in your worship space?



Circle the crosses in the picture below. Then color in all the candles you find. There are 14 in the picture. Can you spot them all?

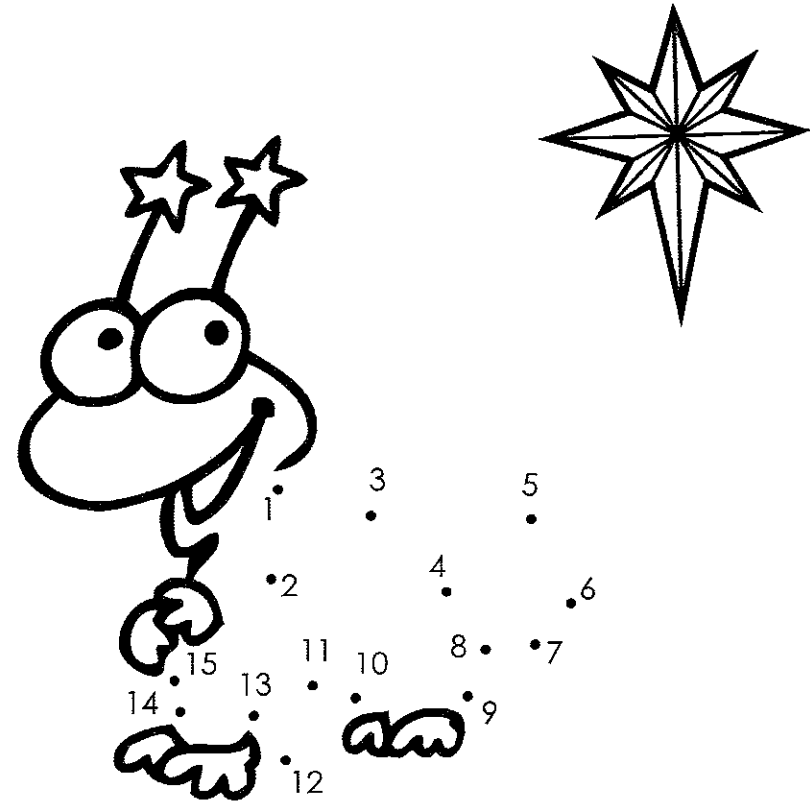


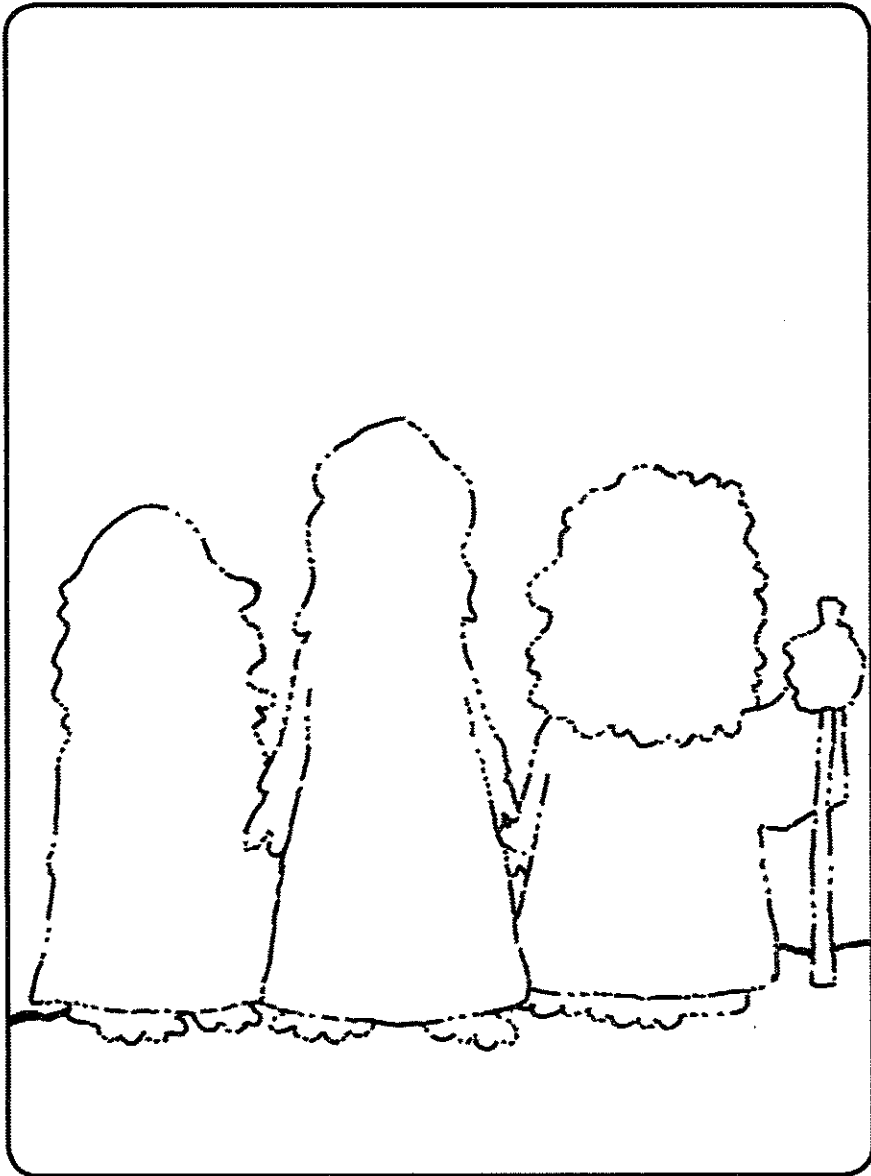

The light is so bright that it's hard to see Squiggles! Connect the dots to make him appear.



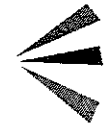
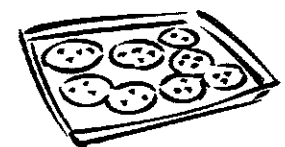
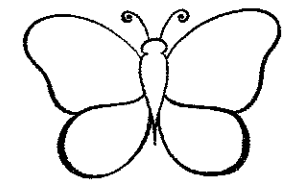


The voice was God!

- 1 God saying “This is my Son, listen to him!” **Draw a cloud around God’s words.**

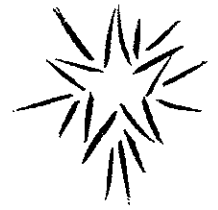

We use this word to give praise to God:

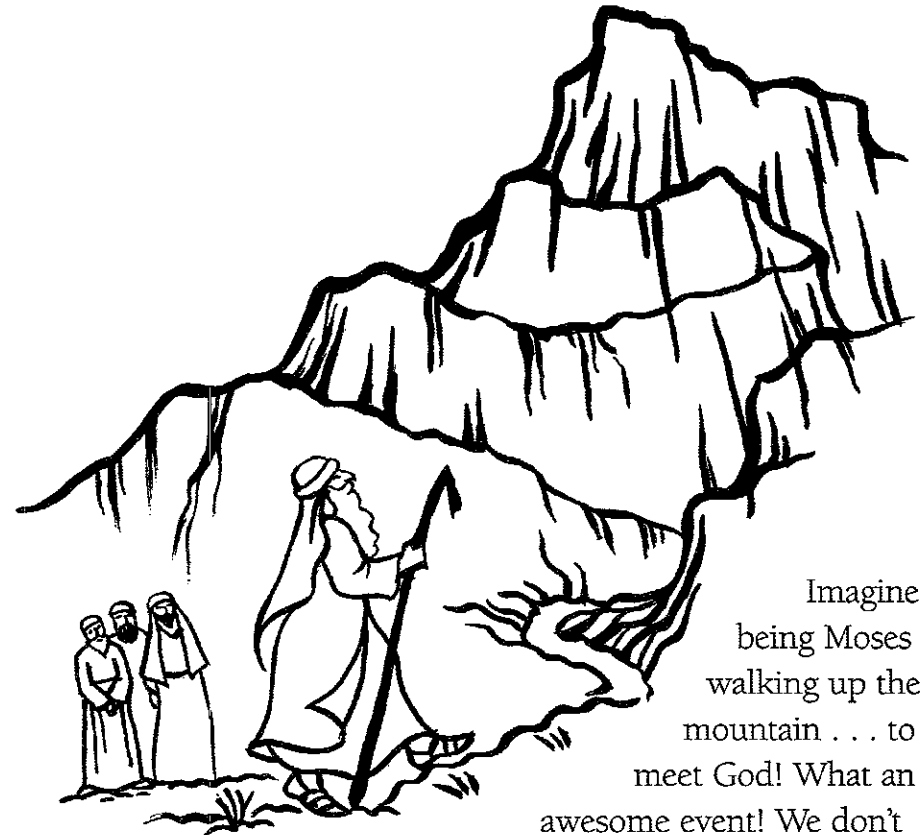
Mountaintop times
