Take someone by surprise by serving them in some way they wouldn't expect like cleaning your room, doing schoolwork, or clearing the table without being told.



The brothers James and John asked Jesus to choose them to help lead the kingdom of God. In their heads they had a picture of greatness, royal palaces, power, and glory.


Draw a picture of the two disciples as James and John imagined their life would be.





What fruits grow on trees? Draw all the tree fruits you can think of in the tree below.




