Dear My Church Family

Thank you so much for participating in our church-wide SURVEY ON BCUMC WORSHIP DURING PANDEMIC in September! I received 30 surveys total. I reviewed them with the members of Re-Opening Task Force and Ad Council and learned the followings:

- All of us are terribly missing In-Person-Worship Service
- Many are missing "Sunday School class" "hugging people" "singing together" "socializing" "being there" "being with friends" "Youth" "choir" "being in God's house" "ALL of it" "inspiration and experiencing God's presence with one another" "a cookie at social time" "live music" "connecting with others, being able to exchanging information" "sense of togetherness" "the atmosphere of worship" "a time to say hello/hi/catch up"
- What people are least missing are "nothing" "getting dressed up and coming to church early" "waiting for husband to get ready for the church" "whispering members during service" "bring kids to church on time"
- While missing in-person gathering very much, people are also very cautious about coming back to in-person service for safety reasons
- There are many reasons why we need to provide ONLINE SERVICE even after the Pandemic is over. Online services will be needed when:
 - o People are sick
 - o People are out of town or working or unavailable
 - o People need extra assurance on the safety of all people
 - o People are living far away
 - o People are somehow late to the service

Based on your suggestions, we decided to make some changes in our Worship Service:

- Reading Prayer List: We will not read the ever-getting-longer prayer list every Sunday during Worship. We will show the list of names on slide while praying in silence and then offer a pastoral prayer for those who are recently lifted up during that week.
- Singing Hymns: We decided to use more familiar hymns and sing up to three verses maximum
- Youth Participation: We will encourage youth members to make a recording of reading the Scripture text for the Sunday
- Sending Sermon-in-Hands: Sermon summary will be mailed or emailed to those who have requested

We still have several things to do more in addition to the changes mentioned here. They include •Bible story time for children; •Utilizing more people to spread the workloads (will be possible after COVID-19 gets more controlled). Someone wants all of us on ZOOM to "unmute" ourselves and sing together but this will be such a mess, technically not a good idea.

I appreciate so many positive feedbacks and appreciating/encouraging words. Someone said "All worship team members have done an amazing job" "Being able to go these services over the internet has kept my faith alive during the COVID shutdown"

Let us continue to worship our loving God together. Our online live worship continues. I am so thankful that many of you have been participating in our live worship service every Sunday. You will continue to receive a ZOOM invitation with the Sunday Bulletin every Friday. You still have three options as follows:

- 1. Watch and interact on **ZOOM**
- 2. **Watch without interaction** live on YouTube (There are clickable links on our website home page and our Facebook page for the Live-Stream Service)
- 3. Watch the recorded service on our web page and FaceBook after 7 pm Sunday

We are apart from one-another but we are together and connected! I am thinking of you every day and praying for you. Let us keep moving forward with our Risen Lord in our hearts!

A LETTER FROM LUGH BAXTER in WISCONSIN



You never give up on me. Grateful.


