

Finance Update

Our Finance Committee is a great bunch of folks who want to see our congregation flourish. I would like to thank them all for their hard work and caring nature. I would also like to thank our office administrator, Michelle Carrillo, for her great work as she is the force that keeps our church on the right track. We all have been tweaking the finance process with good communication and training.

All in all, our church seems to be in rather good shape. Overall, our pledges are on par with what they were last year, being just \$493.00 less. The non-pledge income took a hit because of the pandemic and us not being able to see each other in person. However, because we have not been physically going to our building this saves us a bit in power and utilities and they essentially offset each other. The facility use income is less because we lost some clientele during this difficult time. However, we will see a bump in income from a Love for Learning building rent increase.

Another saving grace has been the Payroll Protection Plans that our government implemented to help us get through this historic crisis. Last year we were loaned \$21,400.00 which went mostly toward church staff salary and this year we were loaned \$19,000.00 which will once again offset church staff salary. Thank goodness last year's loan was forgiven. However, we will need to apply for forgiveness for this year's loan in 2022.

As a committee we went through the budget with a fine-tooth comb and ironed out any foreseeable problems/shortfalls. We decided the best course of action would be to leave the budget as it was before the pandemic, in the hopes that we will be back to in-person services before the end of the year. Fingers crossed! Although we did decide to reduce the budget to better match our reduced services during this pandemic.

In addition, we have been able to pay 100% of our apportionment to the conference.

All these changes put our budget in the positive by \$4,360.99 for the year and will keep us heading in the right financial direction.

A big thanks to Jere Retzer and Tom Miller for the work they accomplished in the beginning of last year. Also, to Larry Schaffer for stepping in the end of last year as chairman and putting together a successful stewardship campaign and keeping the ball rolling with the Payroll Protection Plan.

And thanks again to Michelle Carrillo, our office administrator, and the 2021 finance committee: Joy Kick, Polly Gallagher, Larry Schaffer, John Moore, Jenny Davis, Betty Gaughan, and Joyce Sorensen.
