



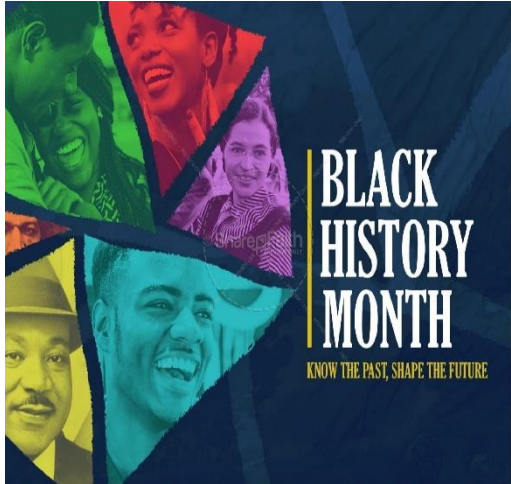

(Afro-American Spiritual. It became the anthem of the Civil Rights Movement of the 1950s and 1960s. It offered courage, comfort, and hope as protesters confronted prejudice and hate in the battle for equal rights for African Americans. But "We Shall Overcome" began as a folk song, a work song. Slaves in the fields would sing, 'I'll be alright someday.' It became known in the churches and published in 1901: "I'll Overcome Someday.")
