

This year the Finance Committee would like to make a more realistic budget based on what our members feel God is asking them to contribute to carry on our ministries as Christians in our community. Congregations that approach financial stewardship

Congregations that approach financial stewardship from a biblical perspective do not view the money

Christians give to their church merely as a way to pay its bills. Rather, such congregations see their relationship with God by supporting their church's ministries.

Our congregation's Finance Committee has selected the **New Consecration Stewardship Program** as a way to express biblical and spiritual principles of generous giving as our stewardship emphasis this year.

New Consecration Sunday is based on the biblical philosophy of the need of the giver to give for his or her own spiritual development rather than the need of the church to receive. We are people who are followers of Jesus Christ who want to give unselfishly as an act of discipleship. New Consecration Sunday encourages people towards giving in response to the question, "What percentage of my income is God calling me to give?"

During the September 26th morning worship, our leader will conduct a brief period of instruction and inspiration, climaxed by members making their commitments as a confidential act of worship. Every attendee and member who complete an **Estimate of Giving** card does so voluntarily.




