

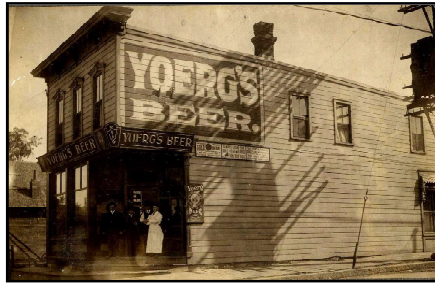
# Minnesota's First Beer

Saint Paul's Yoerg Brewing Company was founded in 1848, ten years before Minnesota became a state, and was Minnesota's first commercial brewery. The Yoergs were originally from Bavaria and were very instrumental in the building of early Saint Paul and were one of the city's most prominent and revered families.



Anthony Yoerg was the founding father, marrying Alexander Ramsey's nanny and together, they had seven children. His two oldest sons Frank and Anthony Jr. were both city council members and prominent members of the St Paul school boards. The beers they produced were long considered Minnesota's best. The Yoerg family used the old Bavarian way of "Steam" brewing their beers because there wasn't refrigeration back then and they aged their lagers in the Wabasha Caves where the brewery sat on Ohio and Ethel streets.

The brewery was happy to keep production small. They produced 35,000 barrels of beer in 1890 and only 18,000 barrels of beer in 1948. just enough to support the family.

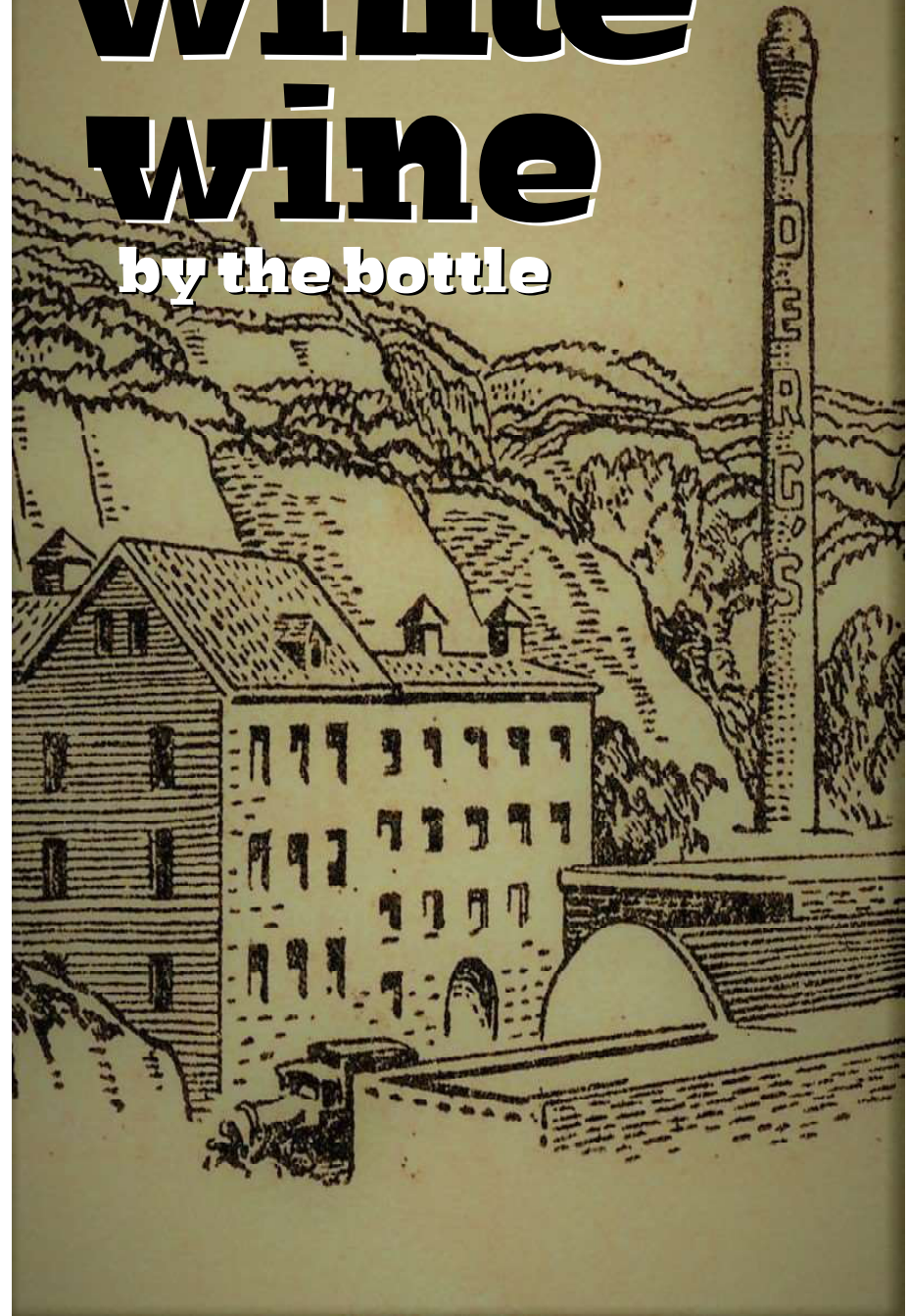


By the early 1950s, beer tastes had changed, the big brands were now made with corn and rice, and were much lighter than Yoerg's legendary lagers, and the brewery just couldn't compete anymore so they closed their doors for good in 1952.



Yoerg's fabled beers have now been resurrected, utilizing the same recipes the Yoerg family used 150 years ago using 100% Minnesota Barley & Washington State Hops. Produced with great care and dedication to detail, these are once again Minnesota's finest beers.

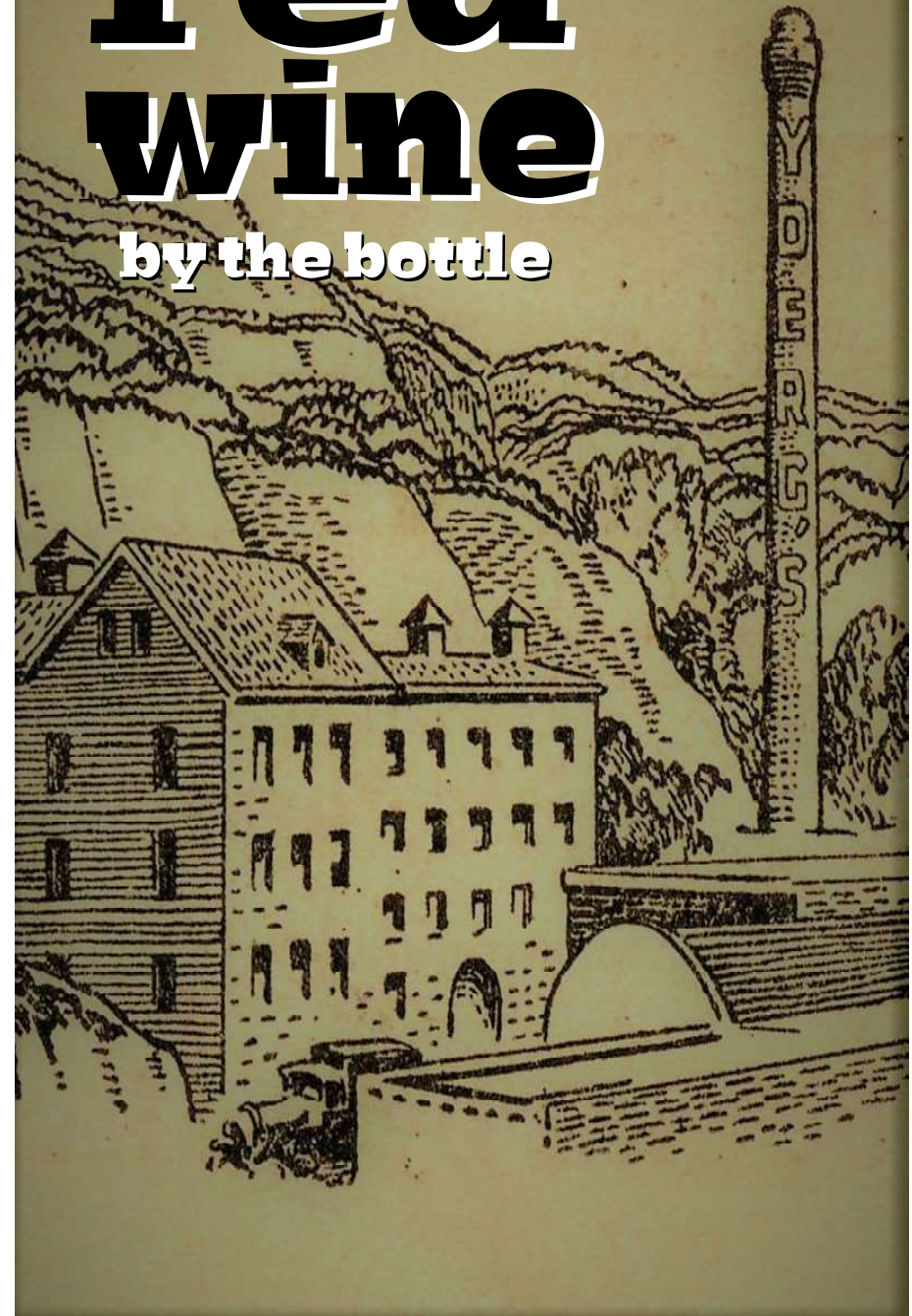
