NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, DETERMINING AND ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN BY CASTING LOTS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, has adopted the provisions of Article 1143, Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, which provides for two year staggered terms of office for the Mayor and Aldermen, and the terms of each shall be determined by lot;

WHEREAS, drawings have been held, and the results are as follows:

THAT the persons above named in the positions stated shall serve for the term of years set opposite the name of each.
THAT thereafter all members of the Board of Aldermen shall be elected and hold office for the terms of two years and until their predecessors have qualified.
