NO. 13C

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I, OF ORDINANCE NO. 13,
PASSED BY THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, TEXAS, (NOW
TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS) ON OCTOBER 1, 1975, PROVIDING
FOR CHARGE FOR COMMERCIAL WATER TAPS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH,
TEXAS:

THAT Section I, of Ordinance No. 13, passed by the
Town Council of the Town of Whispering Oaks, Texas, (now Town
of Woodloch, Texas) on October 1, 1975, be amended by adding
Section I (3), to hereafter read as follows:

"SECTION I.

RATES

(3) That there shall be charged and collected by
the Town of Woodloch, Texas, from all resident and non-resident
commercial consumers of water and water services, per con-
nection or tap, the sum of Twenty-Five and No/100 (\$25.00)
Dollars per month."
