

Motion was made by Sam Wolff, seconded by
Al Stewart, that the following Ordinance be passed:

NO. 26

AN ORDINANCE BY TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS, CHANGING
ITS NAME TO TOWN OF WOODLOCH, AND SETTING OUT
REASONS; PROVIDING FOR ASSUMPTION OF ALL OPERATIONS
AND OBLIGATIONS, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Whispering Oaks is duly and
legally incorporated as a municipality under the General Laws
of the State of Texas, is situated in the Matilda Wilburn Survey,
Abstract No. 597, Montgomery County, Texas, in the Southeastern
part of Montgomery County, Texas, and contains within its
limits 47.02 acres;

WHEREAS, there are other adjacent and nearby areas
situated on lower ground in the flood plain of San Jacinto
River, and are subject to periodic flooding and overflow;

WHEREAS, one of said subdivisions bears the name of
Whispering Oaks, Section II, is in the flood plain area of said
River, and in no way connected with the Town;

WHEREAS, the Town of Whispering Oaks is a more ele-
vated area, does not flood, and as a result of the foregoing
the general public is now classifying the Town as being similarly
located with the other areas, all of which is very damaging,
degrading, and to continue to operate under said Town name
would be detrimental to it, and values of real property therein
will decrease;

WHEREAS, at least Ninety-Five (95%) per cent of the
inhabitants of Whispering Oaks, after a proper poll, have made
request of the Council to change the name to Town of Woodloch,

be advantageous to the Town, the inhabitants and property owners thereof;

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that no loss, damage or injury would be suffered by any individual or concern as a result of said change in name, and the Town inhabitants and property owners would reap great benefits thereby:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHISPERING OAKS:

THAT the name of the Town of Whispering Oaks, a municipality, be and the same is hereby ordered and changed to Town of WOODLOCH.

THAT all signs, emblems, stationery and other data be changed or corrected.

THAT the Town of WOODLOCH shall assume and be liable and responsible for the payment of all debts, notes, bonds, warrants, certificates of indebtedness, and all other obligations of every kind and character heretofore made, issued and outstanding by Town of Whispering Oaks without any change or correction being made therein, and same shall be paid when due, upon presentation.

THAT any and all acts and things required to be done by Town of Whispering Oaks shall be assumed and taken over in full by Town of WOODLOCH, and be performed by it.


THAT all Ordinances, Resolutions, Motions and acts that have been passed and approved by Town of Whispering Oaks shall continue in full force and effect under Town of WOODLOCH.

THAT the Town Secretary is hereby directed to notify the postmaster, depository bank, all financial and lending

THAT this Ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage and approval.
