

RESOLUTION 2010-004

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF RURAL AFFAIRS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR PRO TEM TO ACT AS THE TOWN'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE TOWN'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Woodloch desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Town of Woodloch to apply for funding under the 2011/2012 Texas Community Development Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Program application for the Community Development Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the Town with the Texas Department of Rural Affairs.
2. That the Town's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
3. That the application be for \$350,000.00 of grant funds to carry out Water System Improvements.
4. That the Town Council directs and designates the Mayor or the Mayor Pro Tem as the Town's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the Town's participation in the Texas Community Development Program.
5. That the Town agrees to commit \$17,500.00 in matching funds toward the construction of the Water Systems Improvements project.
