

**TOWN OF WOODLOCH**  
**Resolution 2012-001**

WHEREAS, certain areas of the Town of Woodloch are subject to periodic flooding and other natural hazards with the potential to cause damages to people properties within the area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodloch desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the cities and counties in the H-GAC Region, in order to meet this requirement, have initiated development of a regional, multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, including the Town of Woodloch;

NOW, therefore, be it resolved, that the City Council of the Town of Woodloch does hereby:

Adopts the Houston-Galveston Area Council - Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update; and,

Vests the Montgomery County Office of Emergency Management with the responsibility, authority, and the means to:

- (a) Inform all concerned parties of this action.
- (b) Develop an addendum to this Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update if H-GAC's, a city's, a county's or a district's unique situation warrants such an addendum.

Appoints the Montgomery County Office of Emergency Management to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to the Town of Woodloch's addendum to the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update be developed and presented to the City Council for consideration.

Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Hazard Mitigation Plan – 2011 Update.
