

RESOLUTION NO: 07282022 - 1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOODLOCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT – DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CDBG-DR PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Tropical Storm Imelda (DR-4332) severely impacted the Town of Woodloch; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Woodloch desires to increase resilience to disasters and reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of loss of life, injury, damage to and loss of property, and suffering and hardship, by lessening the impact of future disasters; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Woodloch desires a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Woodloch aims to Affirmatively Further Fair Housing by identifying projects that overcome or do not increase patterns of residential segregation based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability or family status;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Town of Woodloch to apply for funding under the Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WOODLOCH TEXAS:

1. That a Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Fund application is hereby authorized to be filed by the Town of Woodloch with the General Land Office for the recovery and mitigation efforts under 2019 Disasters Infrastructure Competition.
2. That the projects detailed within the application will address major rehabilitation improvements at the Beaumont Water Tower in the Town of Woodloch which were identified as a risk due to Hurricanes/Tropical Storms/Tropical Depressions and Riverine Flooding, thereby placing undue and certain health and safety risks on residents.
3. That the CDBG-DR Application request amount be filed for **\$1,000,000.00**.
4. That the application will require a 1% cash match, based on CDBG-DR application request amount, in the amount of **\$10,000.00** committed by the Town of Woodloch from the General Fund
5. That the total project cost is **\$1,010,000.00** to include construction, engineering, acquisition, and administration services.
6. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the Town's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the


City's participation in the Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program.

7. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, fair housing, and civil rights requirements.
