Instructions for Making Cards



Cubbies can use the following pattern page to make a card for their sibling or friend.

What You Need

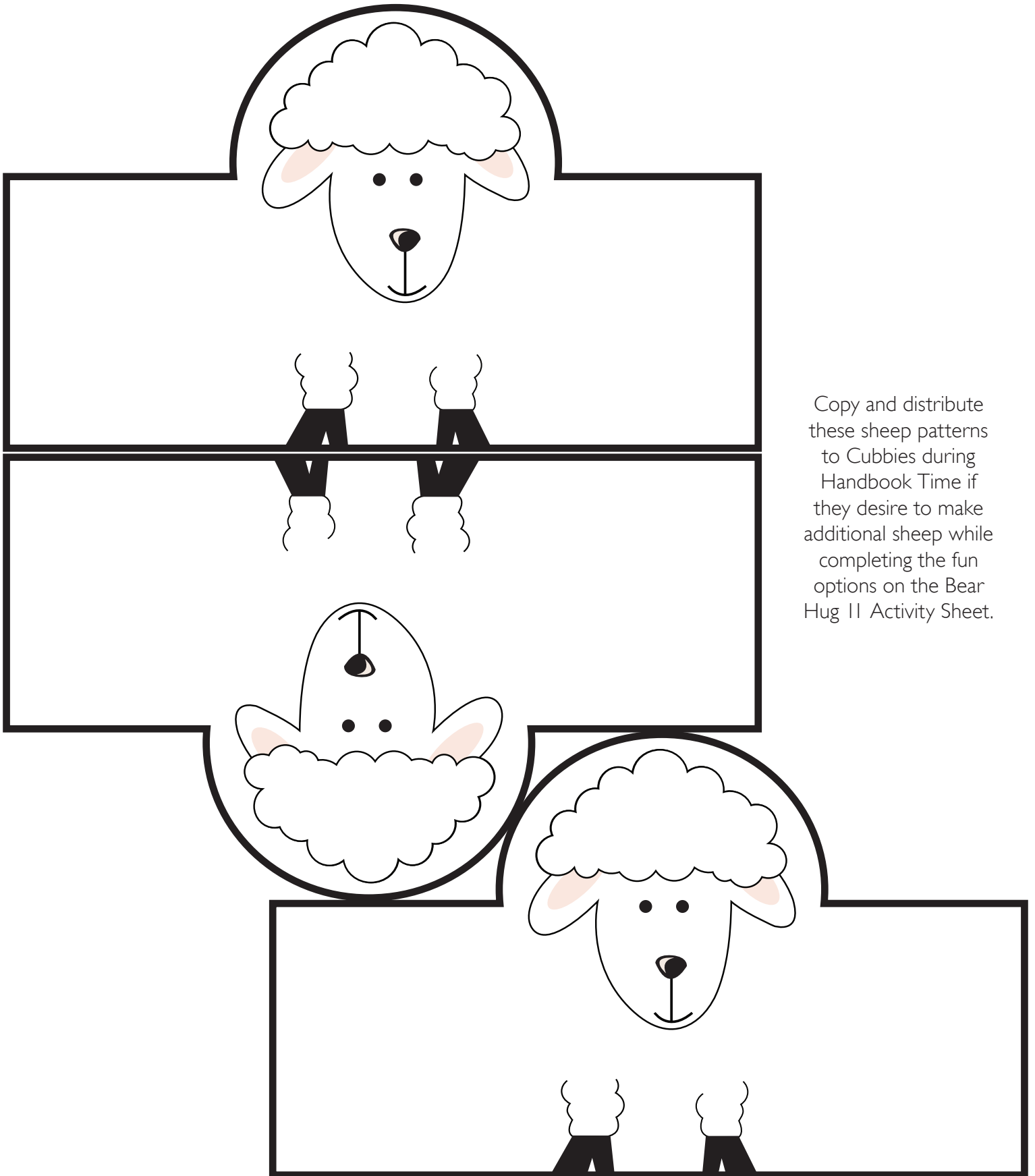
- Printer and (or) copier
- Scissors
- Five empty cardboard bath tissue rolls (if using images in current size and not enlarging)
- Glue stick or tape

1. Print the shepherd, sheep, thorn bush and wolf patterns. Copy or print the page with sheep twice, so you have a total of six sheep (The thorn bush will be used in Bear Hug 12. The wolf will be used in Bear Hug 13.)
2. Cut out all the patterns. Hold the shepherd upright and glue him around a bath tissue roll so he can stand.

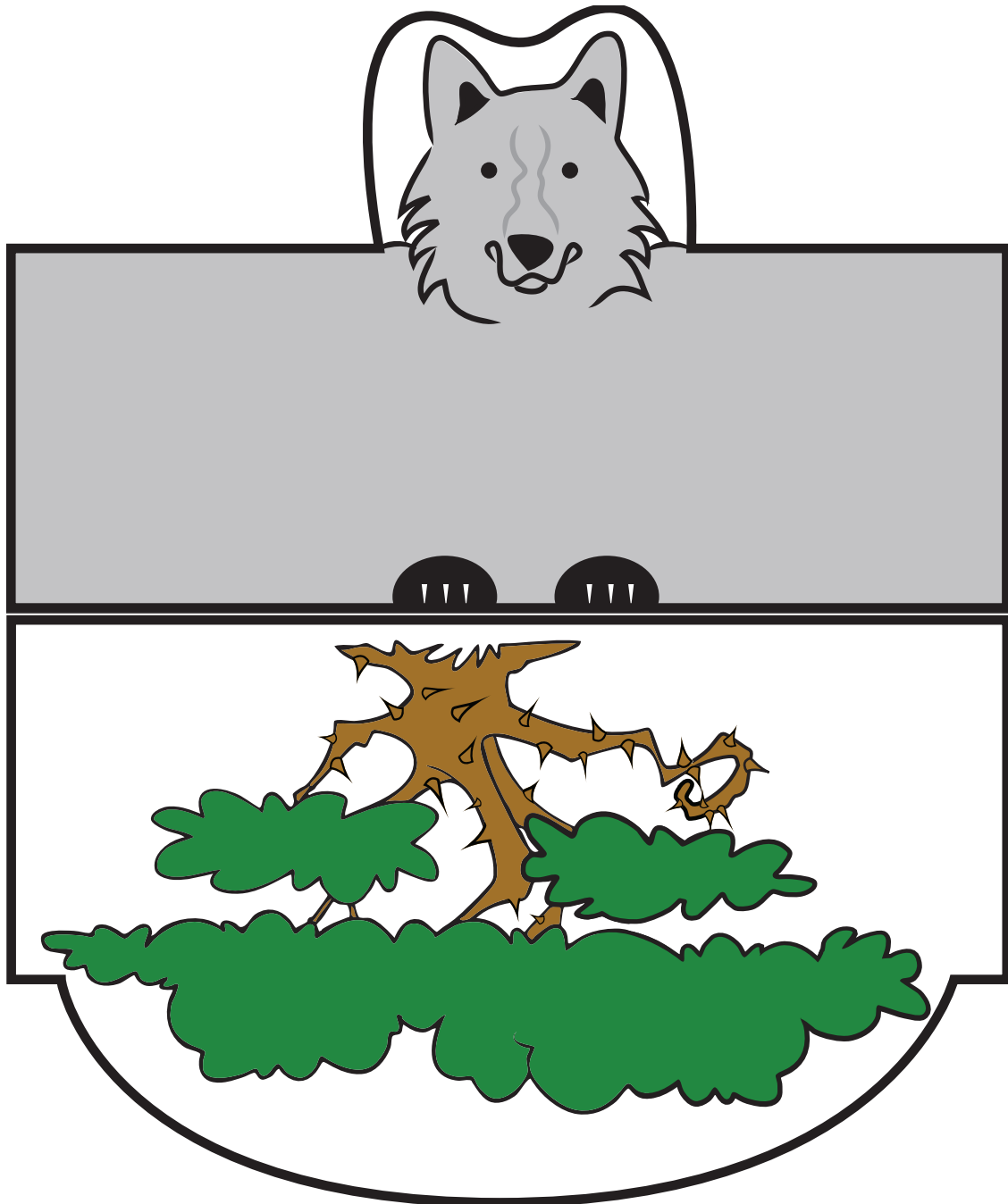

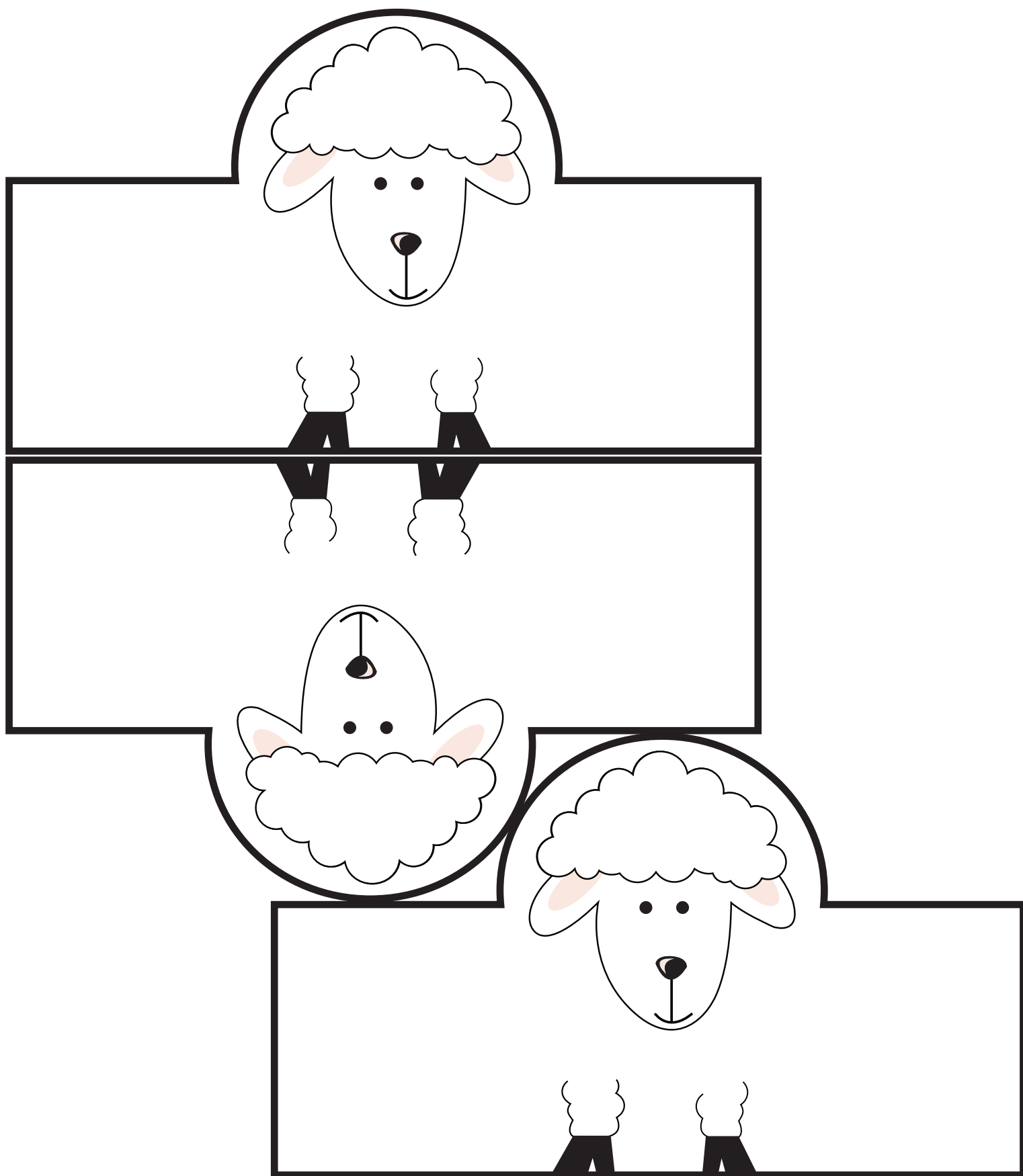
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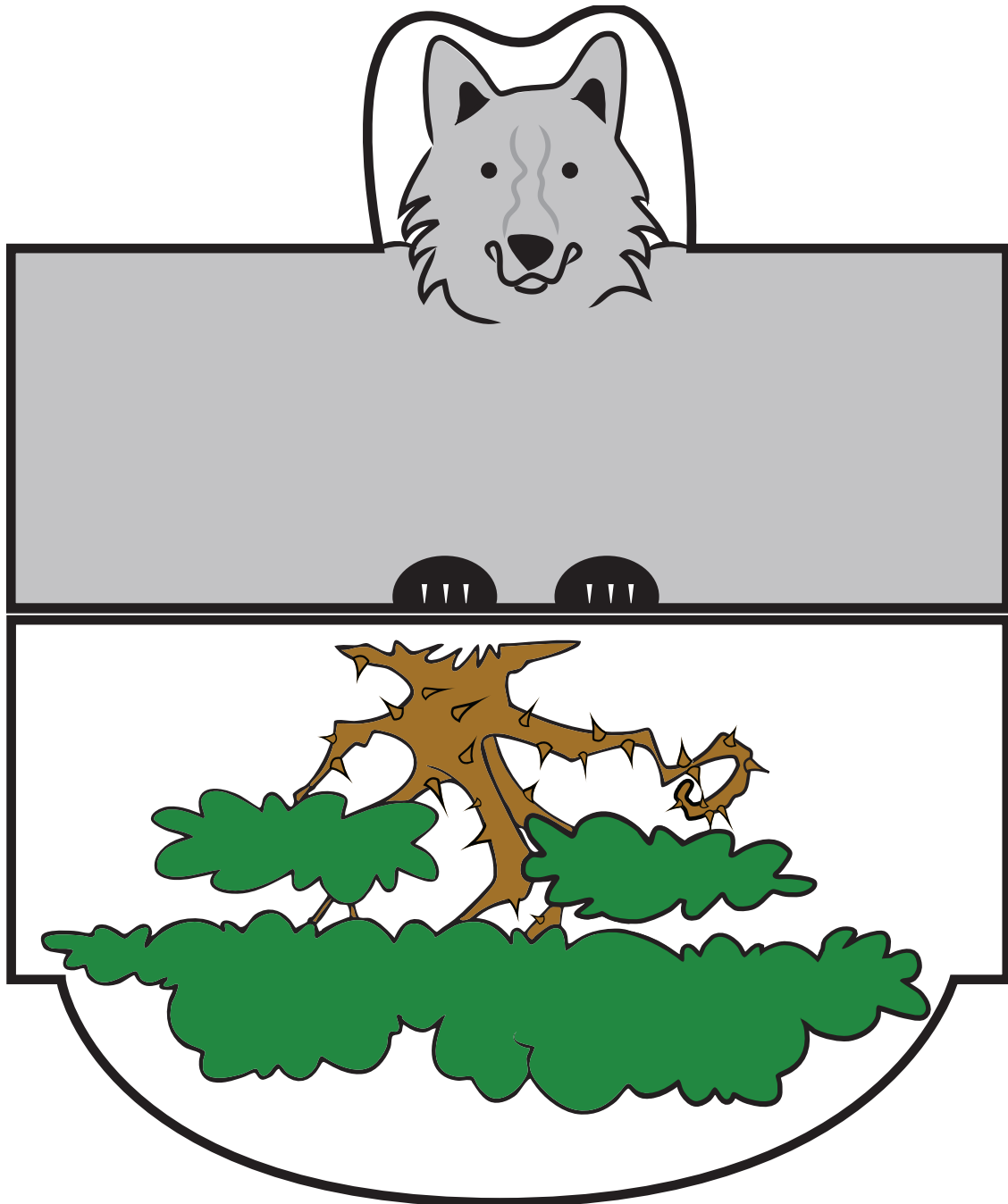
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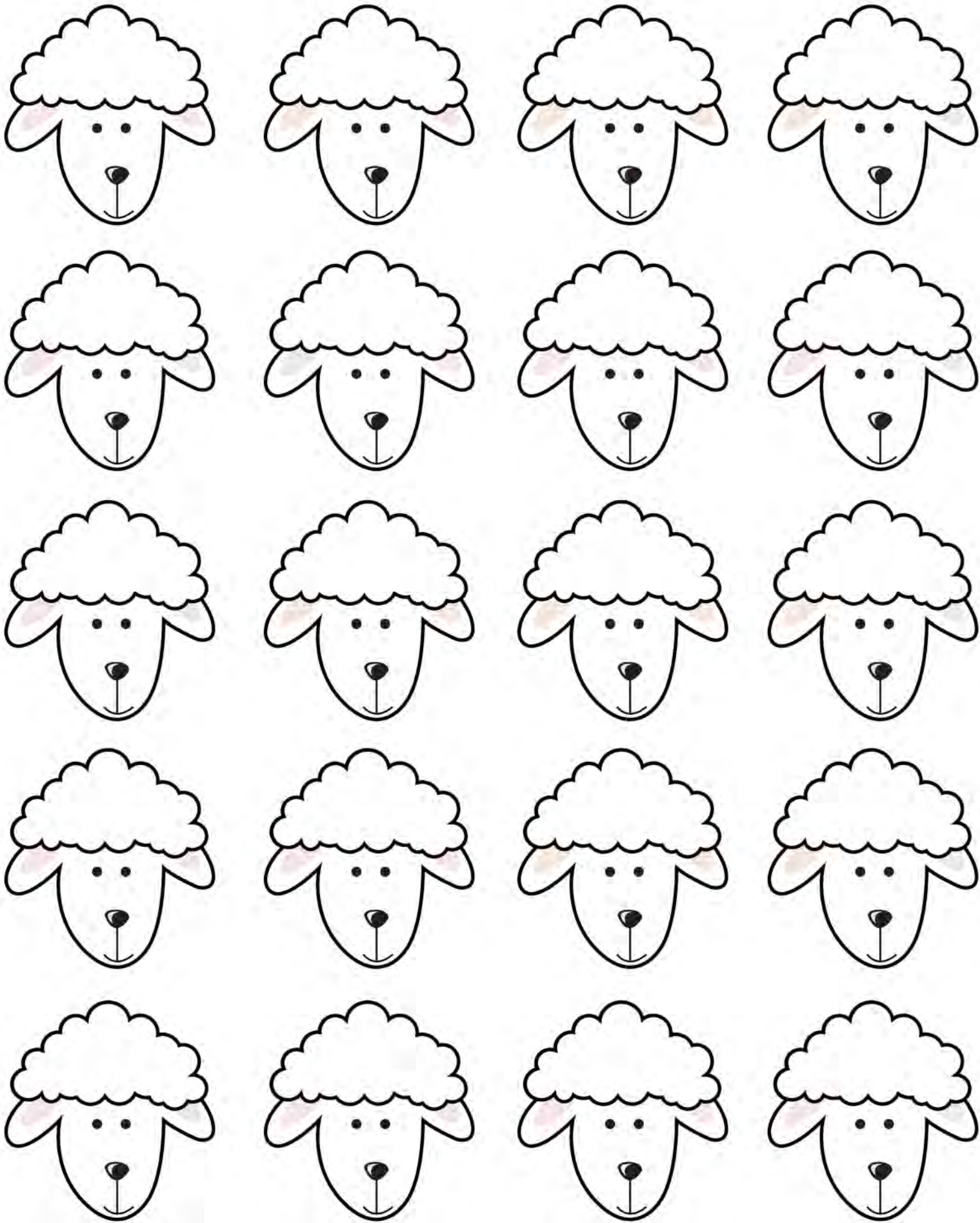
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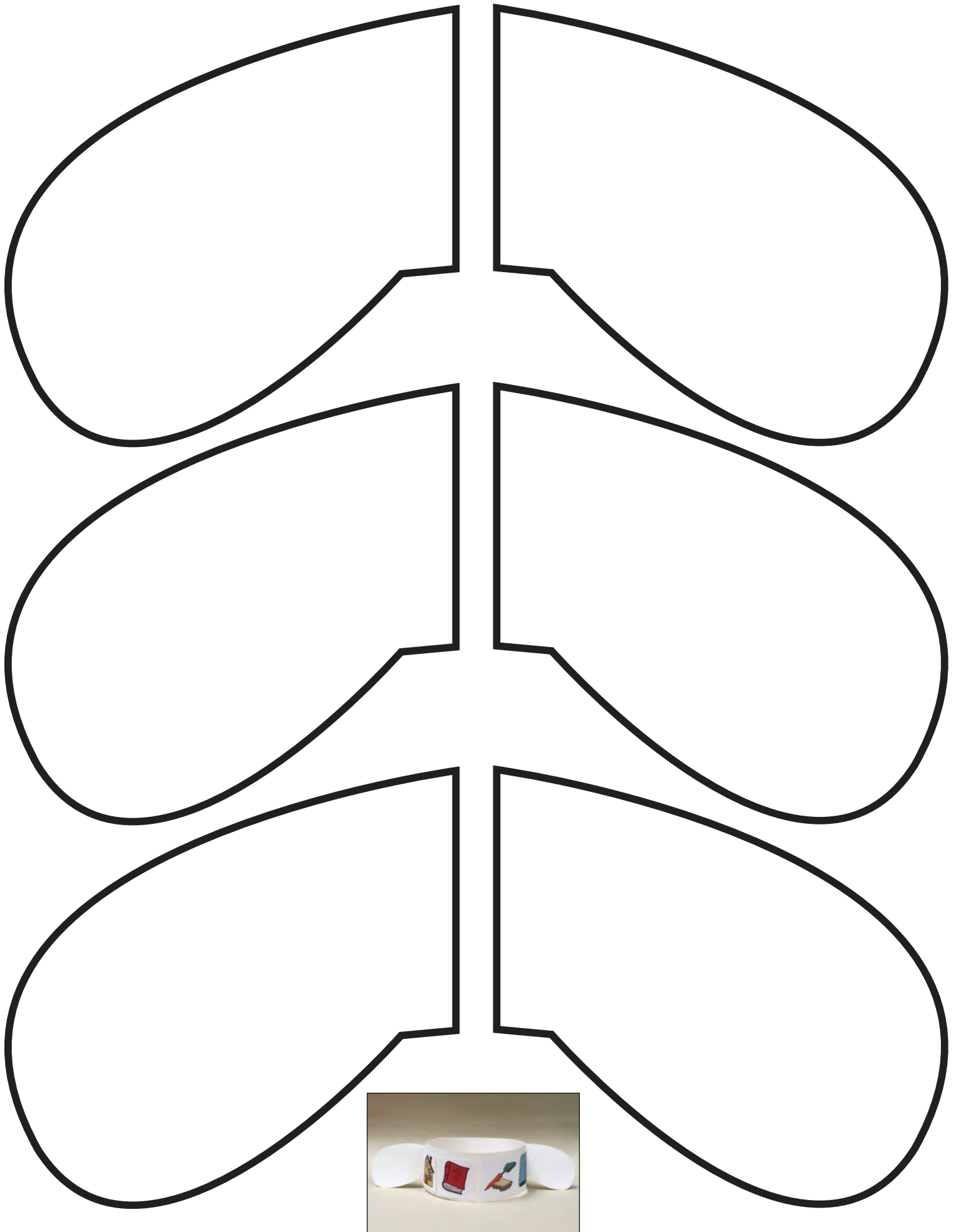
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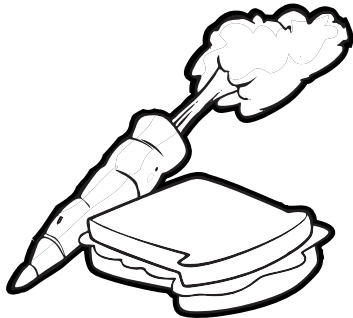
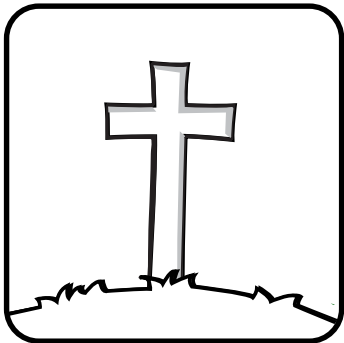
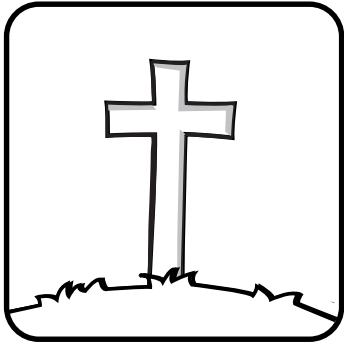
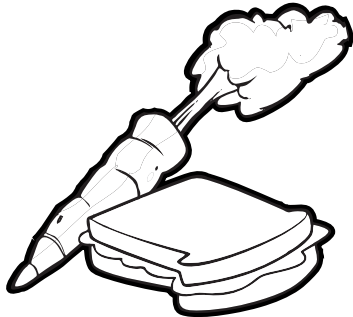
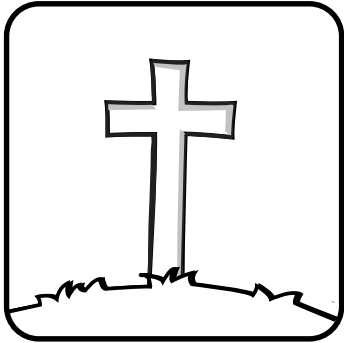
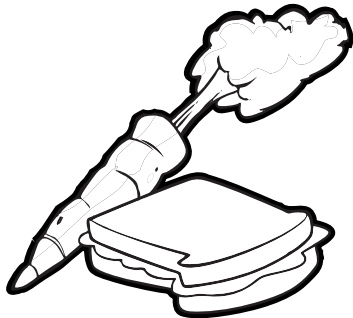
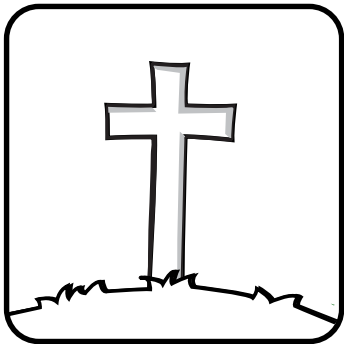
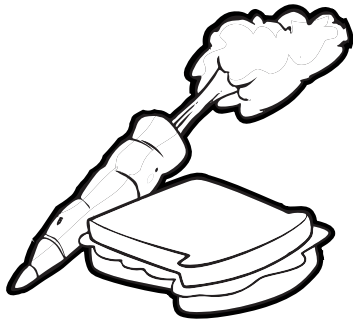
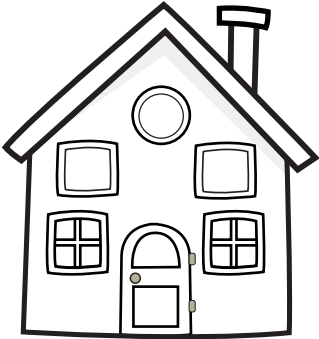
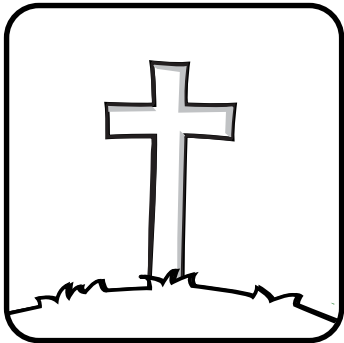


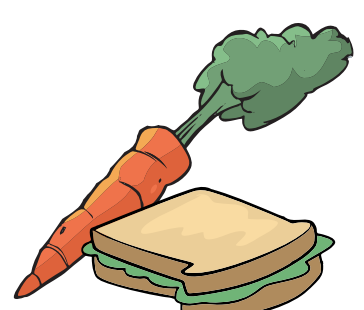
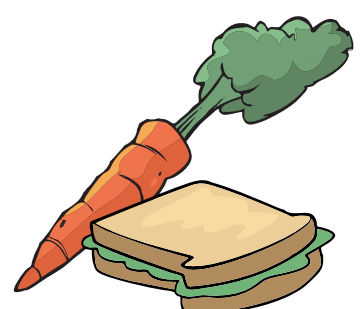
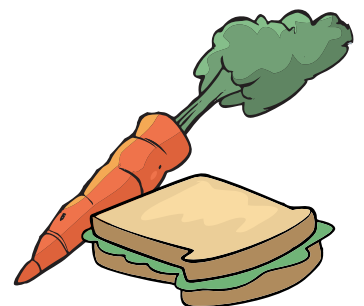
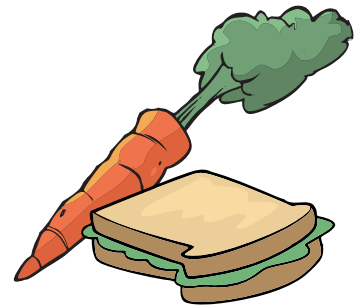
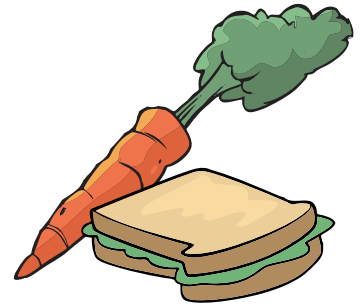












Lost Son Skit

Actors/Helpers

- Narrator
- Prop assistant

What You Need

- Bible
- Picture of a pig or toy pig
- Bag in which to place pig
- Two bathrobes or Bible times robes
- Money (play money or real money)
- Suitcase
- Two party hats
- Candy bar
- Ball
- Bag of peapods (to represent the pods the pigs ate; the pods were likely seeds of the carob tree)
- Ring for son's finger
- Pair of sandals or slippers

(Beforehand, choose your narrator, prop assistant and actors. Adult leaders are best for the roles of the narrator, prop assistant and father. Preteens or teenagers are best for the roles of the son and son's friend. Cubbies are best for the roles of the pigs.)

(Just prior to the start of the skit, give the narrator the Bible and a bag with the pig toy or picture in it. Give the father a robe to wear and the money. Give the rest of the props to your prop assistant, so he or she can help actors during the skit.)

NARRATOR: Cubbies, in this bag is something from our story today. Who would like to come up and pull the item from the bag?

(Narrator chooses a Cubbie volunteer to pull the pig toy or picture from the bag and show it to the group.)

A pig! Are you wondering how a PIG will fit into our story today? Well, we will have to wait and see. *(Narrator opens Bible to Luke 15:11-24.)* When Jesus lived on earth, He liked to tell stories to help people learn about God. These stories are called parables. One day, Jesus told a parable about a father who lost his son. Here is the story Jesus told:

There was a man who had two sons.

(Father and son enter. Father is wearing robe and carrying money.)

The youngest son said to his father —

SON: Father, give me my inheritance.

NARRATOR: Cubbies, do you know what an inheritance was? An inheritance was the money the father promised to give his son when the father died. But the father wasn't even dead yet, and his son was demanding his money. That's sort of rude, don't you think?

But the father was kind, so he gave his son the money.

(Father hands son the money and exits. Son puts money in his pocket.)

A few days later, the son packed up all this things.

(Prop assistant gives son the suitcase.)

He set out on a long trip to a faraway land.

(Son travels around the room carrying his suitcase and then returns to the front of room and sets down suitcase. Friend enters.)

When the son got to the faraway land, he had wild parties with his friends.

(Prop assistant puts party hats on son and friend and gives son a candy bar. Son and friend laugh and look like they are having fun.)

He ate whatever kind of food he wanted.

(Son unwraps candy bar and takes a bite. Then prop assistant takes away the candy bar and gives him a ball.)

He played all day with his friends.

(Son and friend play catch with the ball.)

The son did some very bad things in the faraway land. He broke the rules his father had taught him, and he did whatever he wanted! He was so happy to be rid of his father and his rules forever. He felt so free!

(Son dances and jumps around joyfully.)

But one day all his money was gone. He had spent it all!

(Son hands all his money, the party hat and the ball to the prop assistant.)

Then a famine came to the land — which means that it was very hard for people to find food. The son was hungry and alone. All his friends left him.

(Friend exits and waves to the son.)

Things weren't fun anymore. So the son decided to get a job feeding pigs.

(The two pigs crawl on the floor near the son and make oinking sounds. The prop assistant gives the son the bag of peapods and he drops them on the floor for the pigs.)

He was so hungry that he wished he could eat some of the pods that the pigs ate, but no one said he could have any.

After a while, the son didn't like living in the faraway land anymore. He said —

SON: My father's servants always have plenty of bread, but I'm starving over here. I will go back to my father and tell him I've sinned and I'm sorry.

NARRATOR: So the son started to go home to his father's house.

(Son picks up suitcase and starts walking around the room again.)

Cubbies, what do you think will happen next? How will the father treat his son when he gets home? Will the son be punished (get in trouble)? Will the father be angry? *(Allow speculation.)*

(Father enters and holds his hand above his eyes as if he is looking off into the distance. Son stays towards the back of the room.)

While the son was still a long way from home, the father saw him. Every day, the father had been watching for him. The father was filled with great love for his son. He left his house and ran to meet his son.

(Father pretends to spot son and runs to the son in the room. Father hugs and pretends to kiss the son on the cheek.)

But the son said —

SON: Father, I have sinned against God and against you. I am not good enough to be your son anymore. Please let me be your servant instead.

NARRATOR: But the father didn't like that idea at all. His son would ALWAYS be his son. He loved his son and he forgave him for the wrong things he had done. He said,

FATHER: Servants, bring the best robe and put it on him.

(Prop assistant puts the second robe on the son.)

Put a ring on his hand and shoes on his feet.

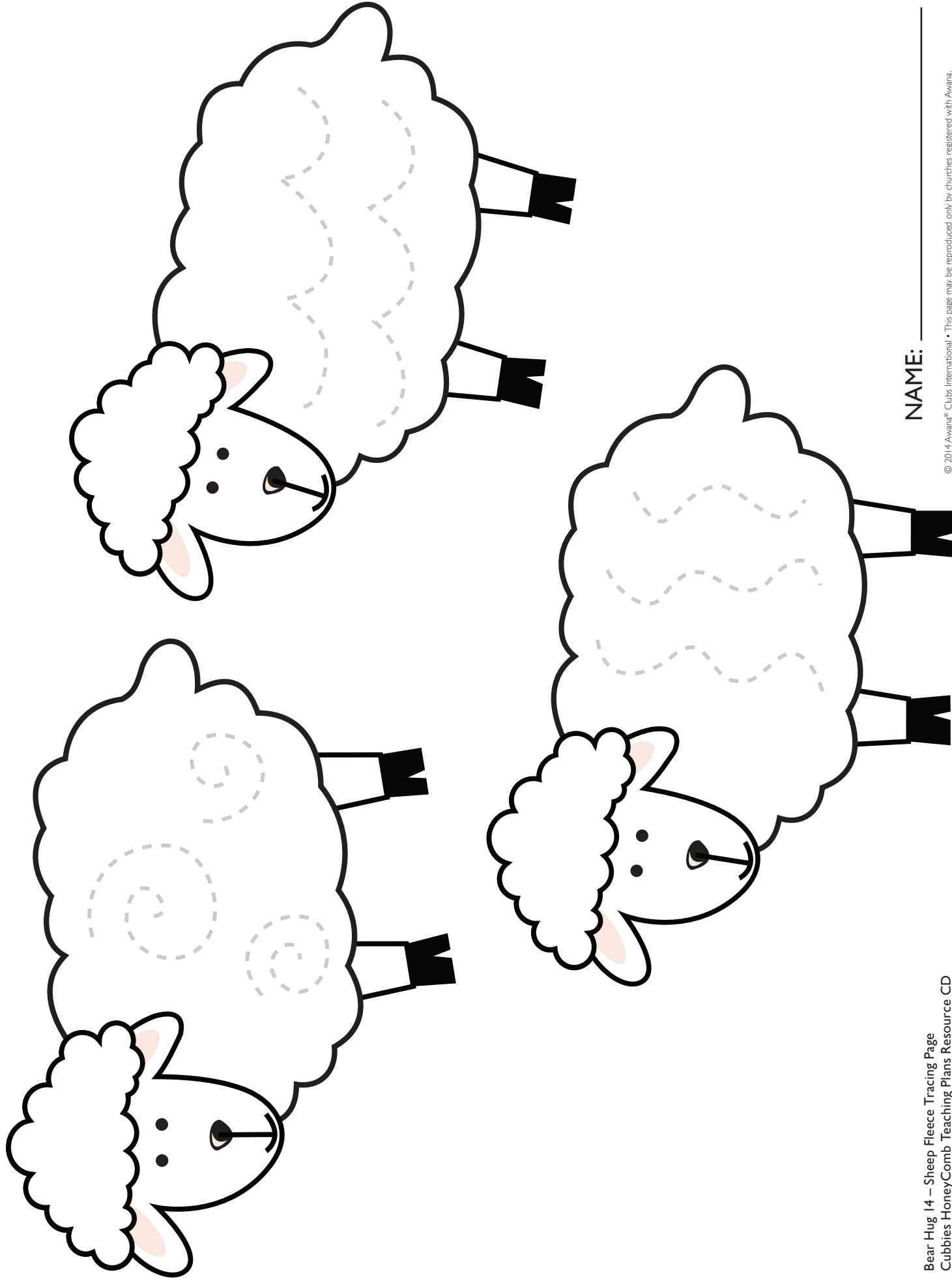
(Prop assistant puts the ring on the son's finger and sets out the shoes for him to slip on.)

Let's have a big party and celebrate! For my son was gone, and now he is back. He was lost, but now he is found!

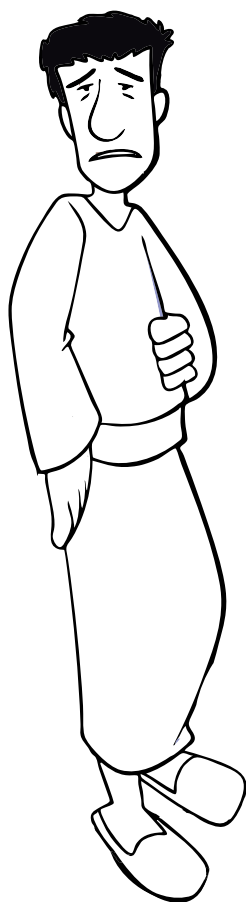
(Father puts his arm around the son and they walk together as they exit.)

NARRATOR: Cubbies, what did you think of Jesus' story? Did you like it? *(Allow reactions.)* Is there anyone in the story who acted like Jesus, our Good Shepherd?

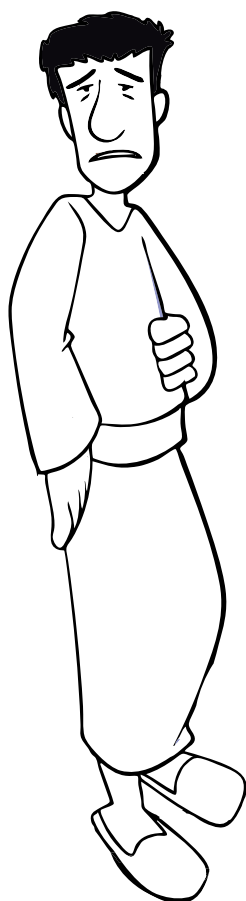
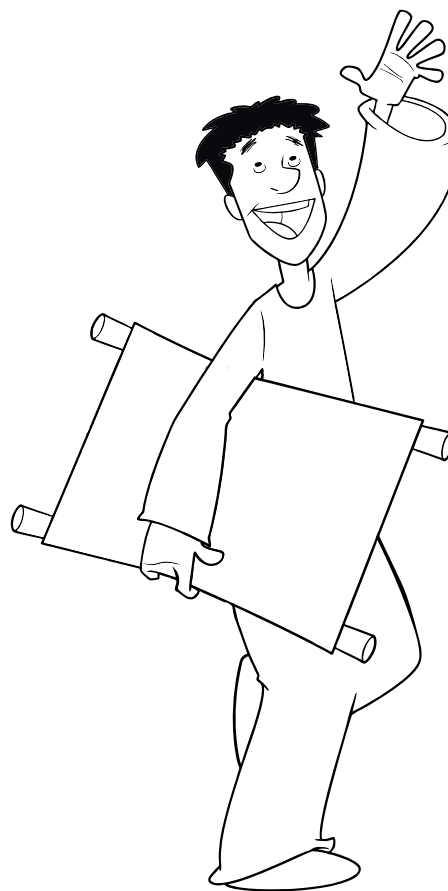

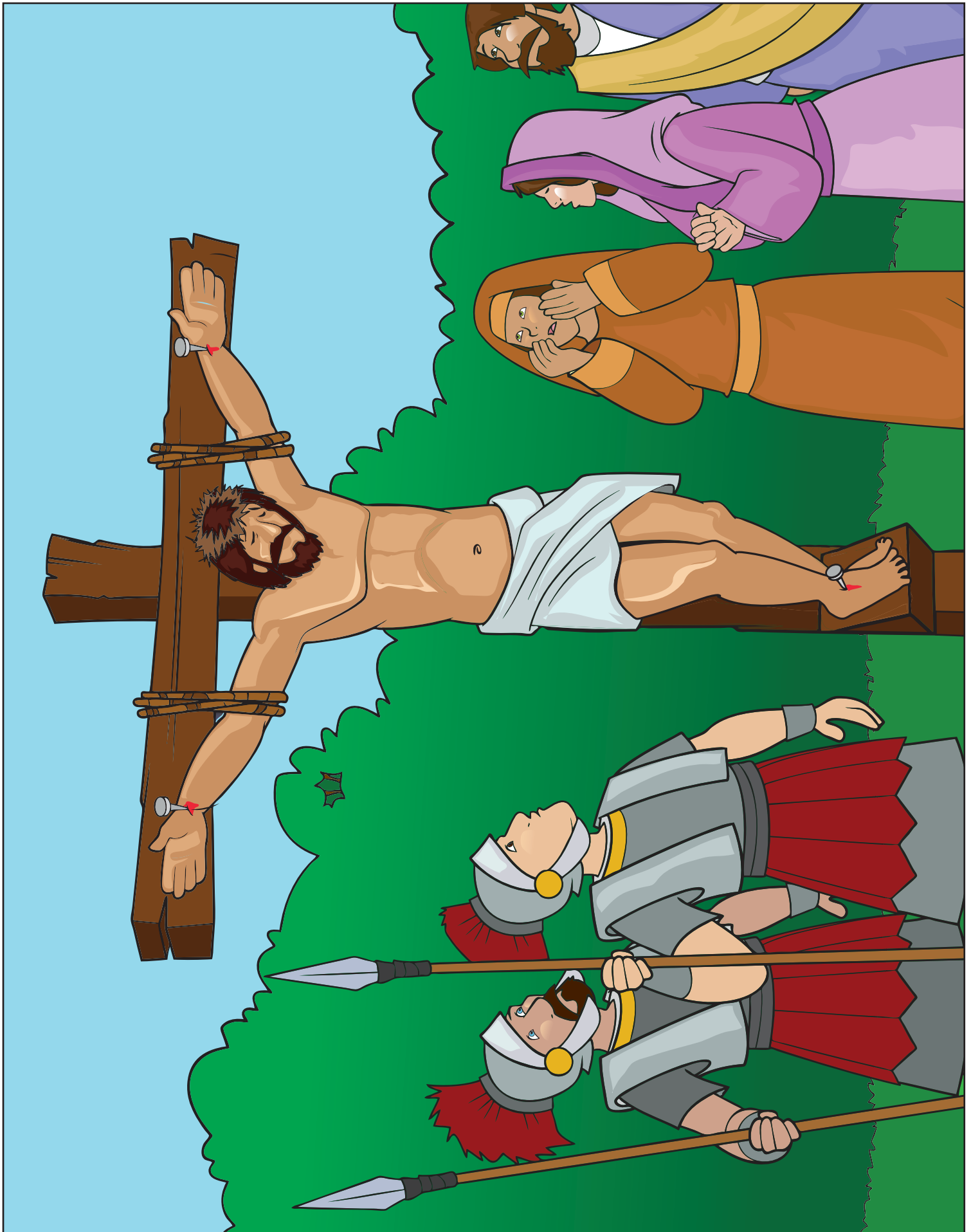








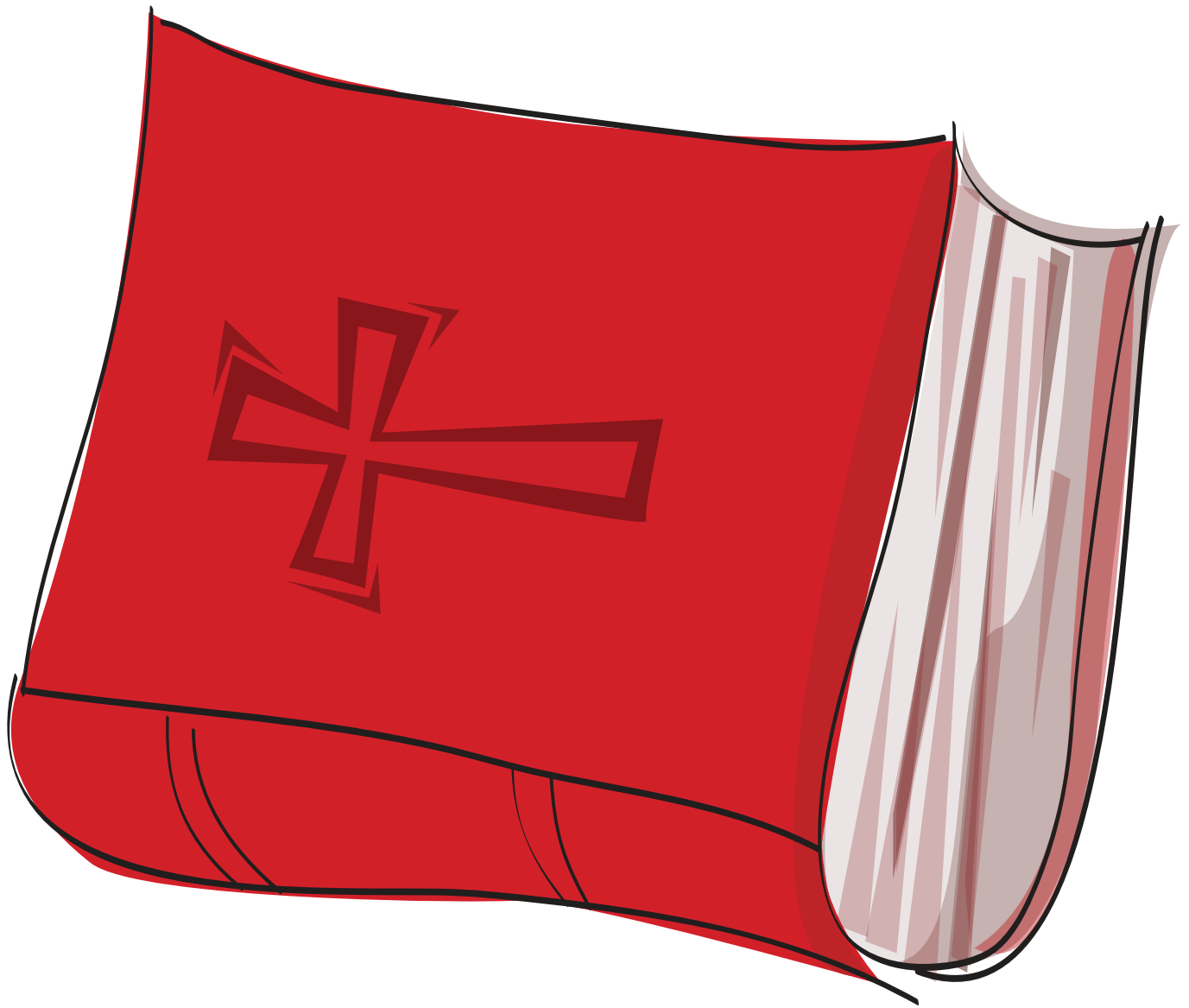


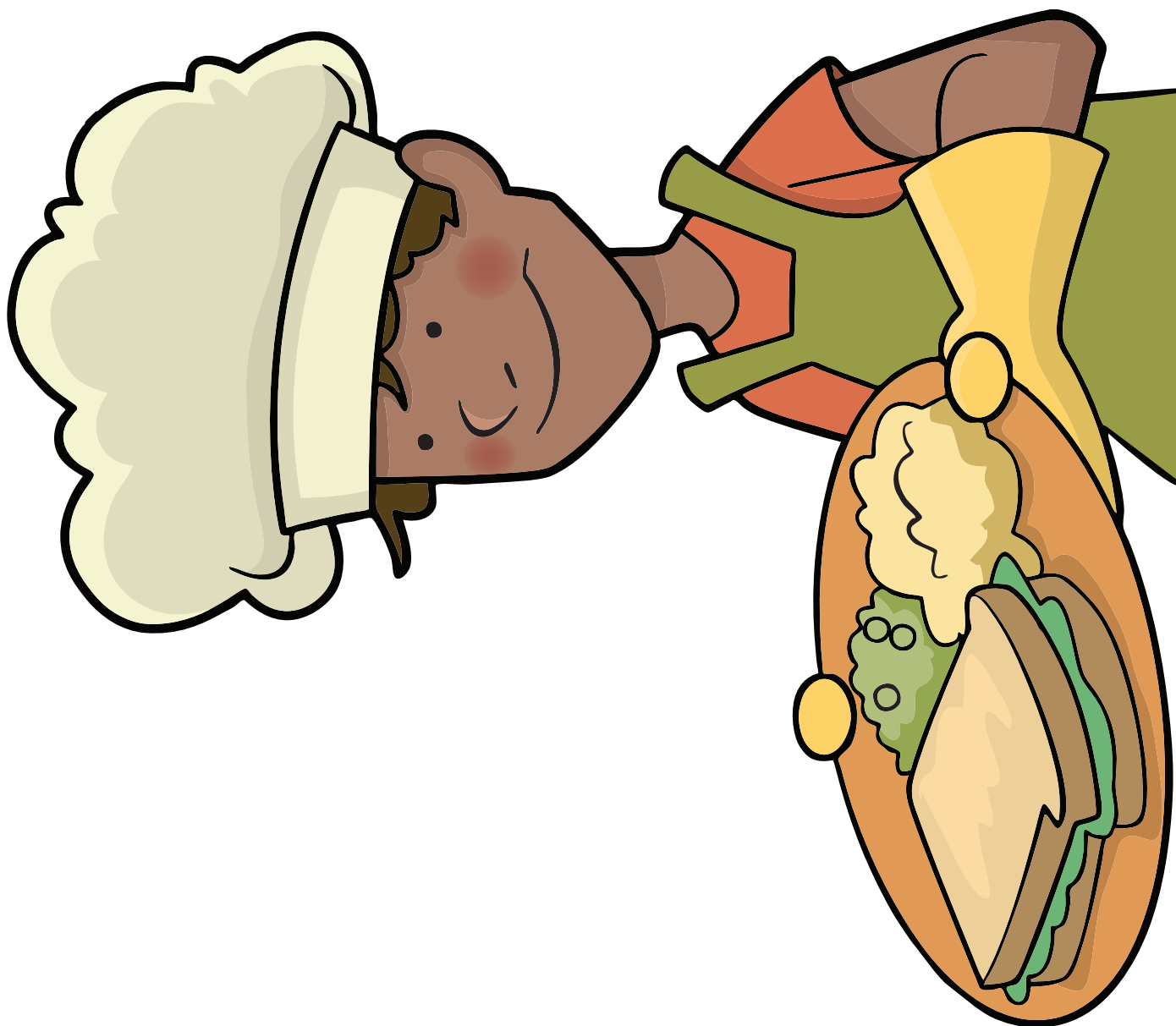












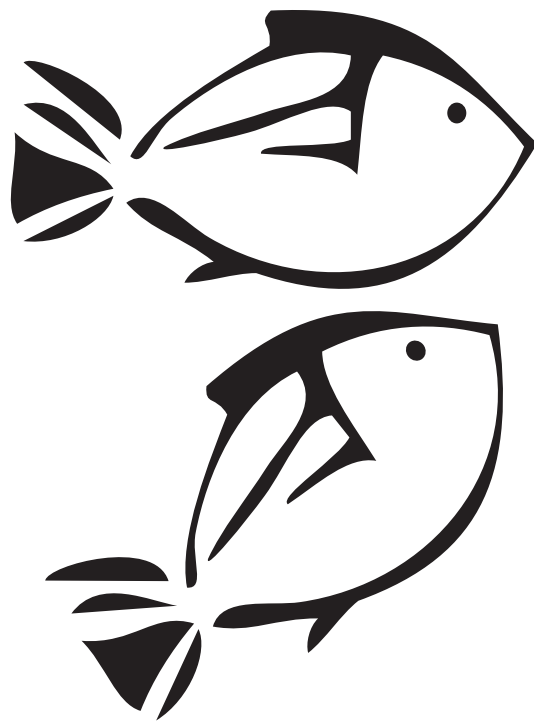
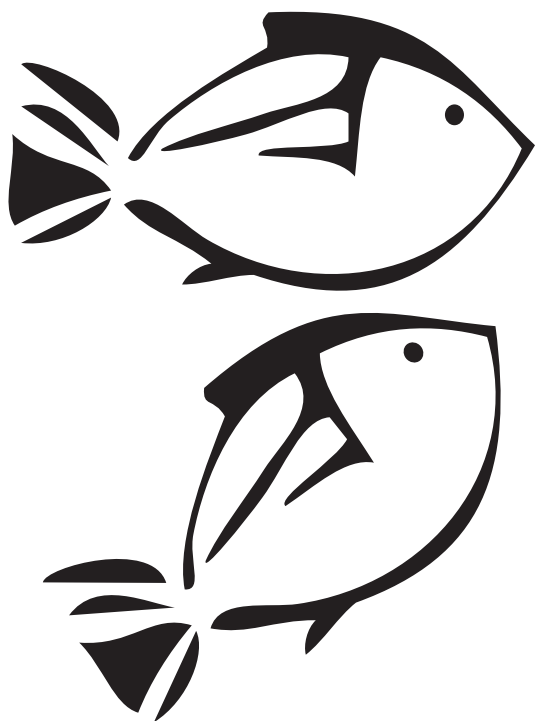
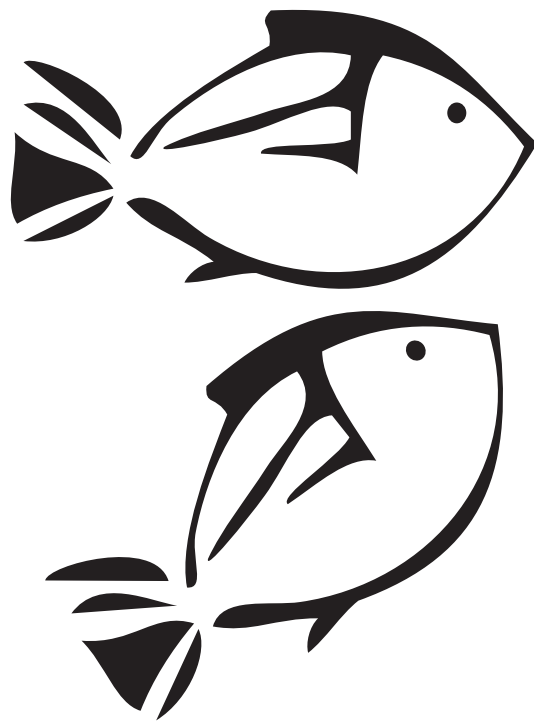
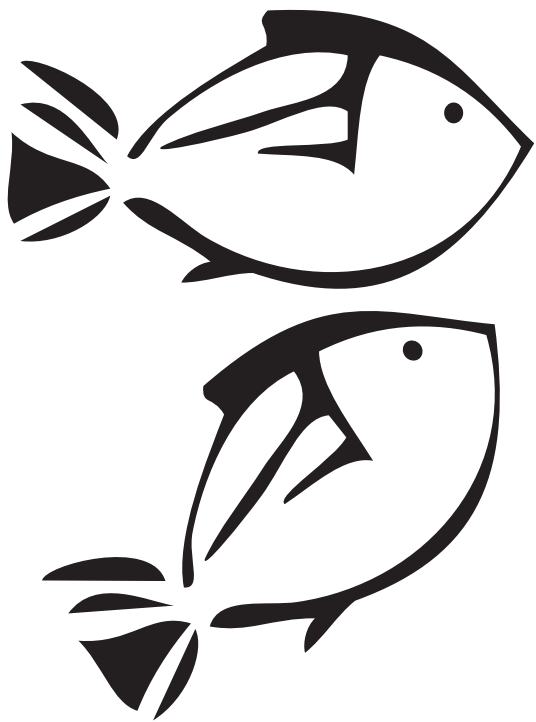
Instructions for Making the Loaves and Fishes Lunch Basket

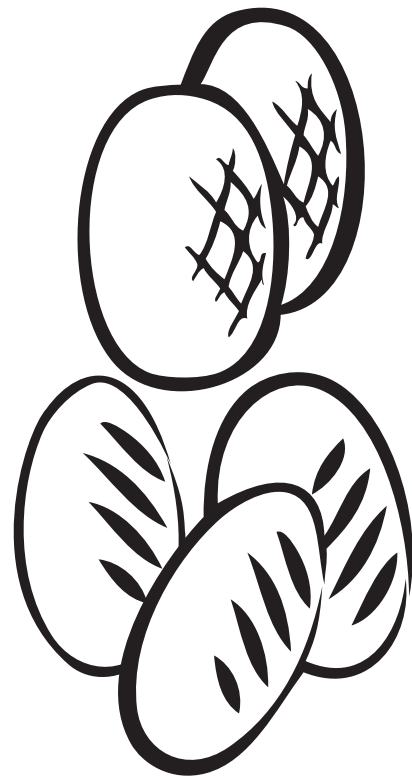
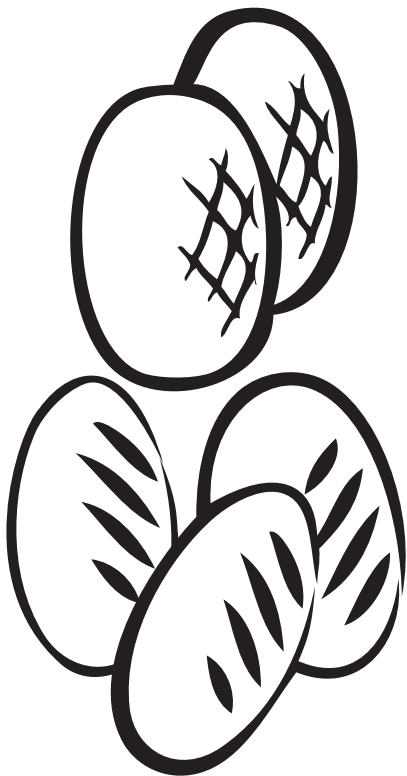
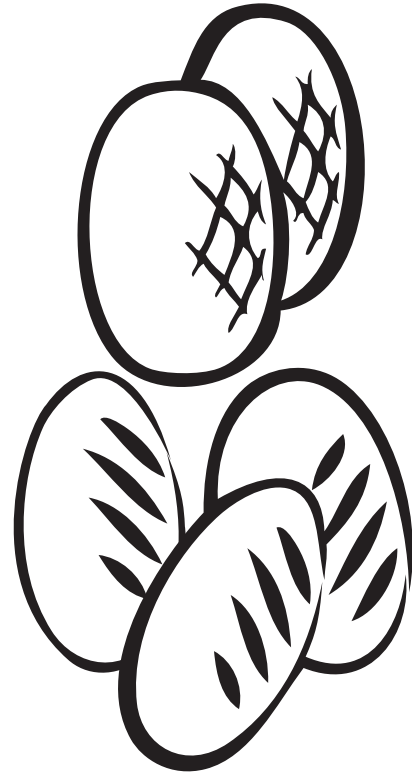
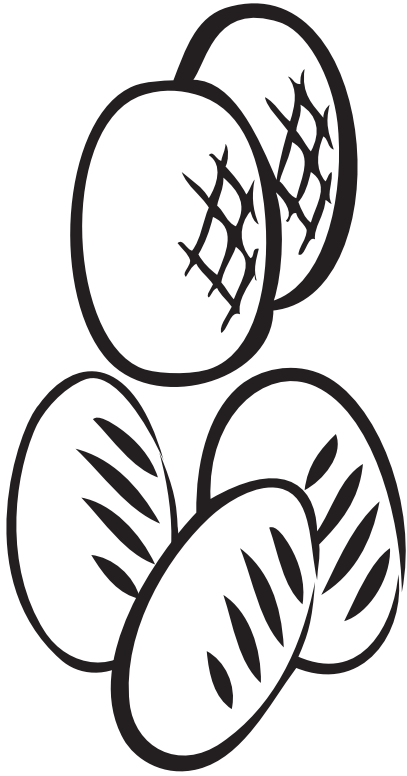
What You Need

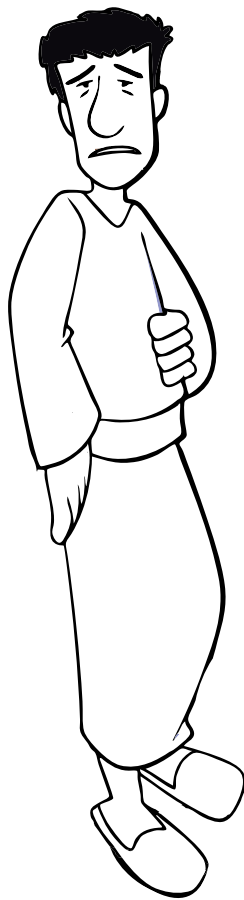
- Loaves and fish patterns (resource CD)
- Crayons
- Brown paper lunch bags
- Pairs of child-sized scissors
- Stapler for leader's use

1. Precut the loaves and fish patterns or let Cubbies cut them out. Cubbies color the patterns.
2. Show Cubbies how to cut off the top portion of a flattened paper lunch bag.
3. Cubbies cut a strip from the top portion of the bag that was cut off. (The strip will look like a circular band because it was cut from the bag.)
4. Cubbies cut through one side of the strip (along where the bag used to be folded) so the strip becomes one long, flat piece.
5. Cubbies open the bottom portion of the bag to make the basket. Leaders staple the strip to the basket to form a handle.
6. Cubbies place their fish and loaves patterns in the basket and use the craft to retell the Bible story to someone.

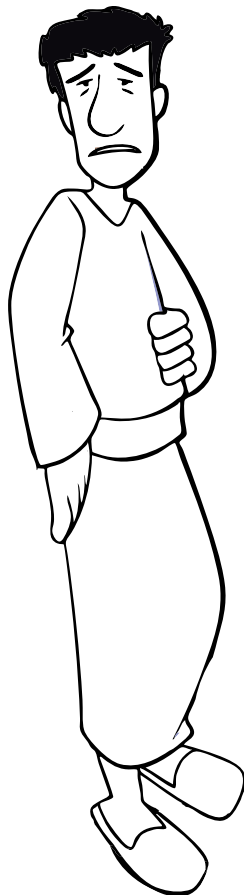
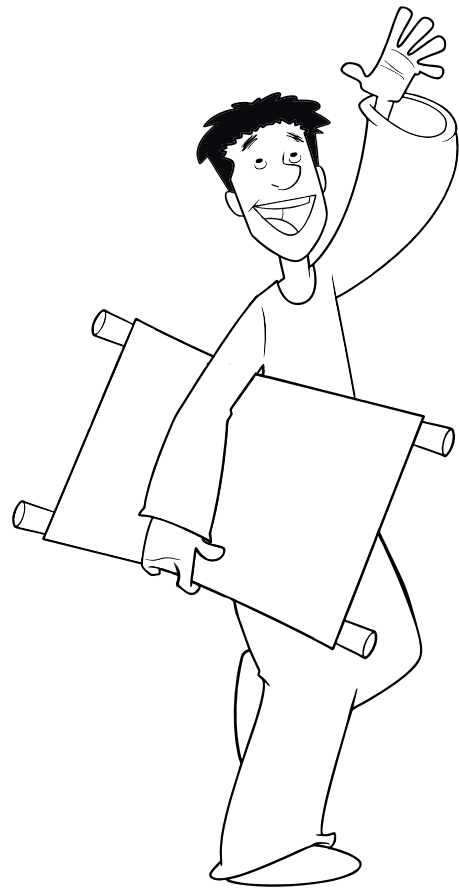




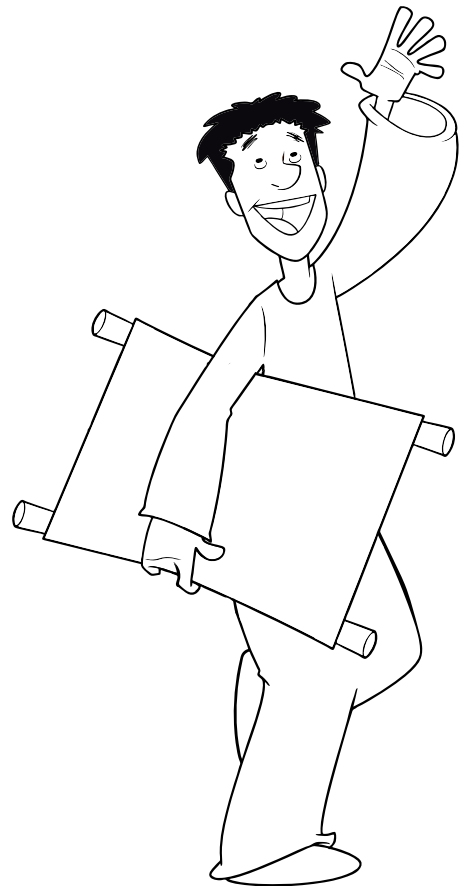

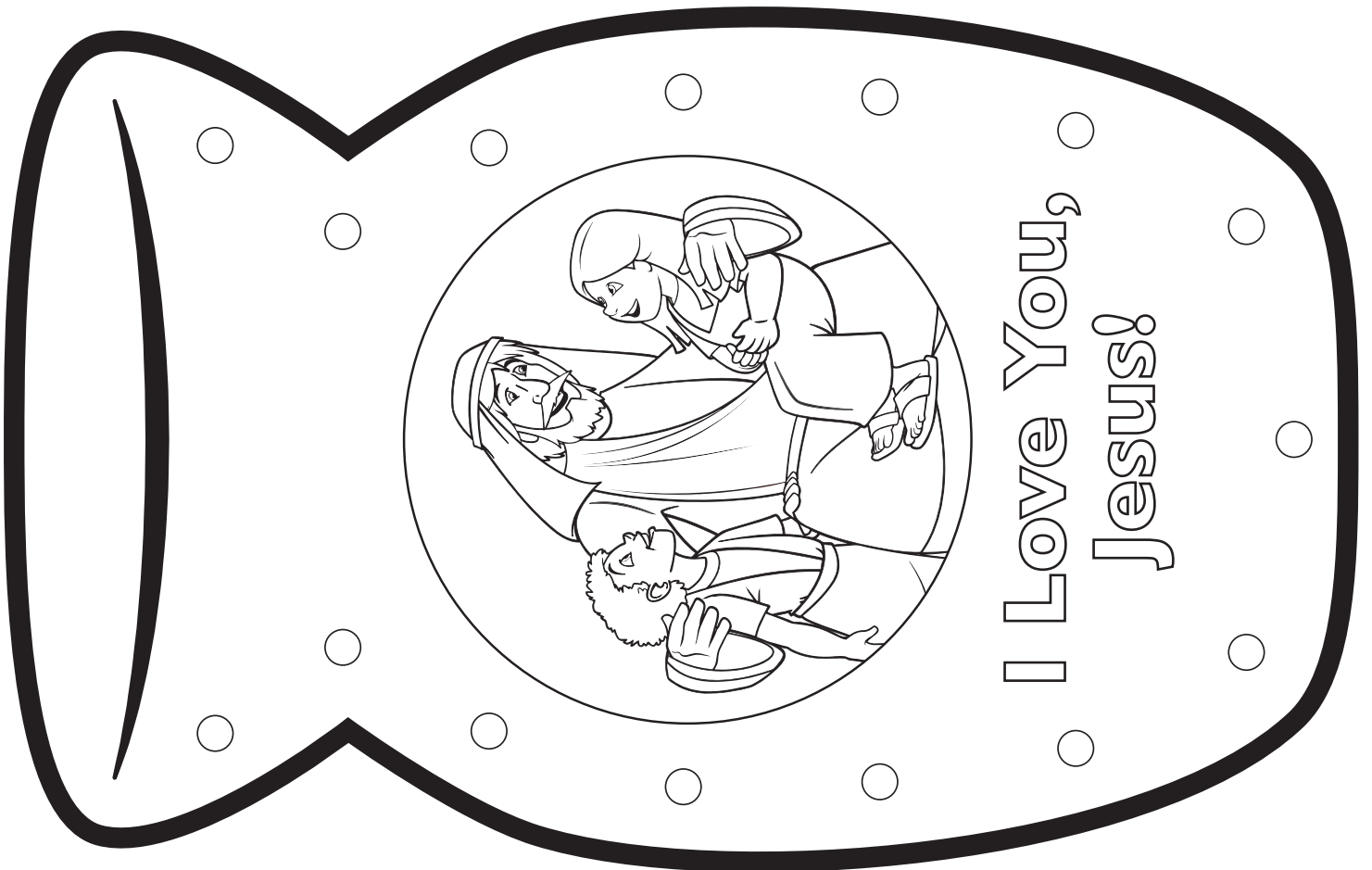
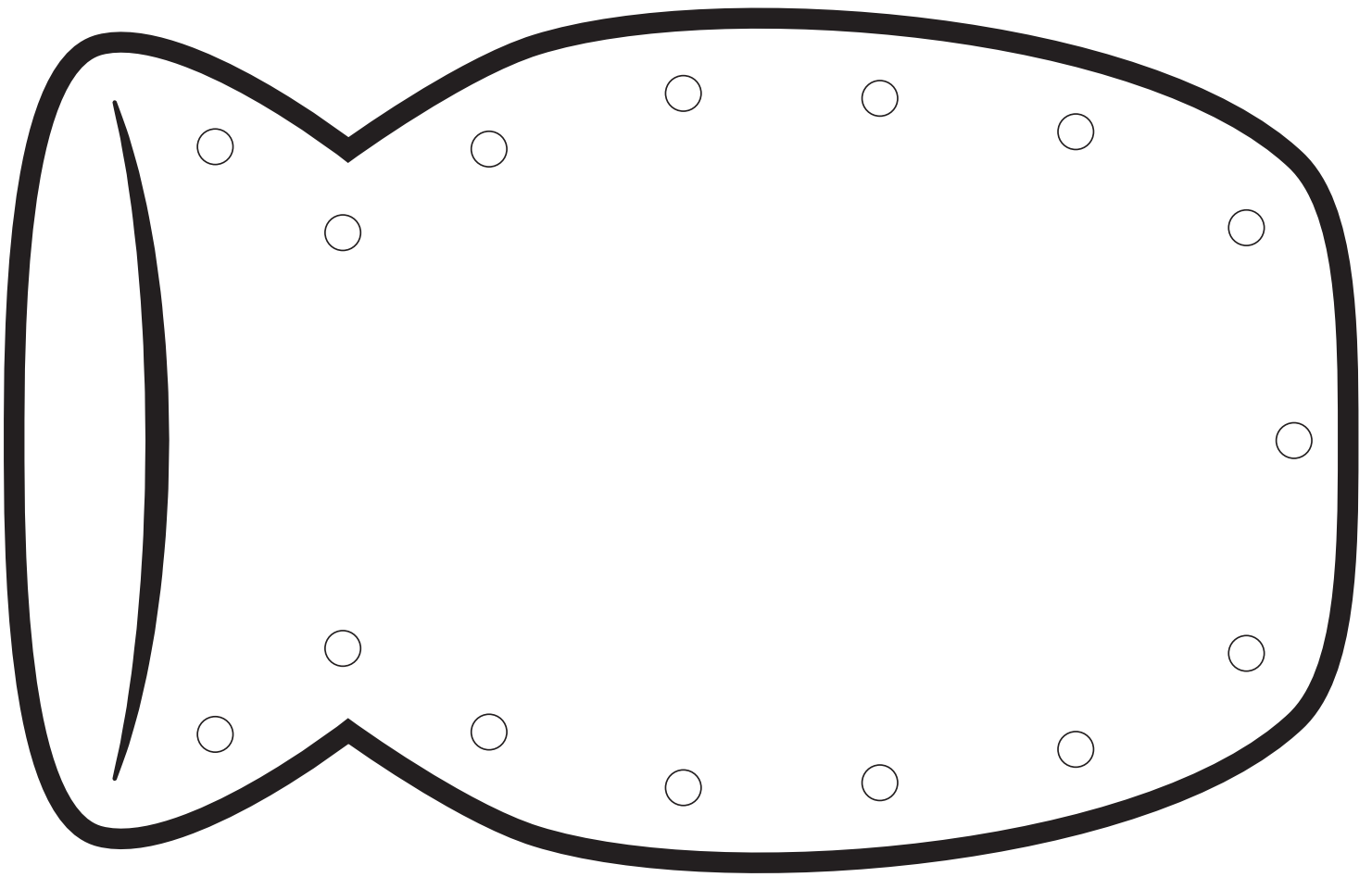




“I Love You, Jesus” Jar Craft Instructions

1. Cut out the jar patterns for Cubbies and punch holes at the appropriate locations around the jars.
2. Fit two jar patterns on top of each other so the holes line up. Thread an 18” yarn piece through one of the holes at the top of the jar and secure at one end with a knot.
3. Wrap a piece of tape around the unknotted end of the yarn to make it stiff for lacing.
4. When Cubbies arrive, give them each a jar craft that is ready to lace.
5. After Cubbies are done lacing around the jar, leaders secure the yarn with a knot at the last hole at the top of the jar. The mouth of the jar should remain open.
6. Cubbies can color their jars.



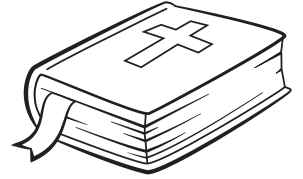

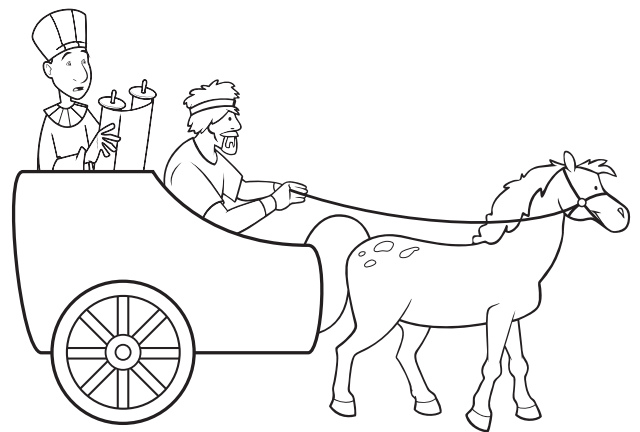
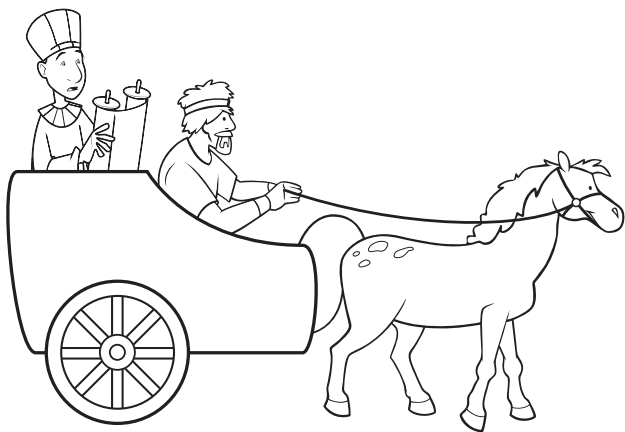
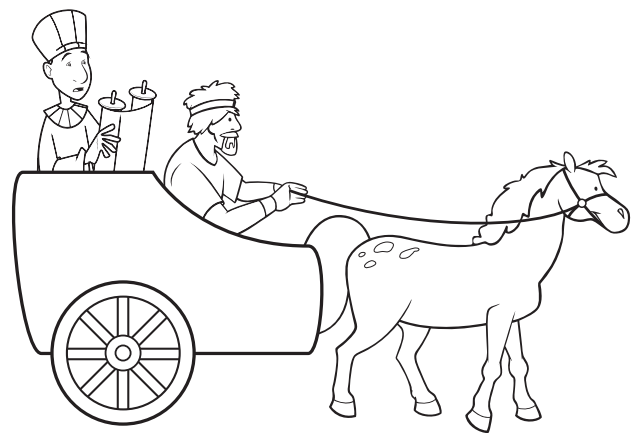
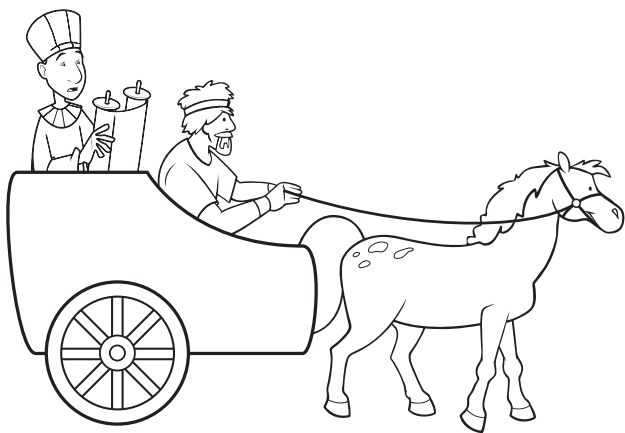
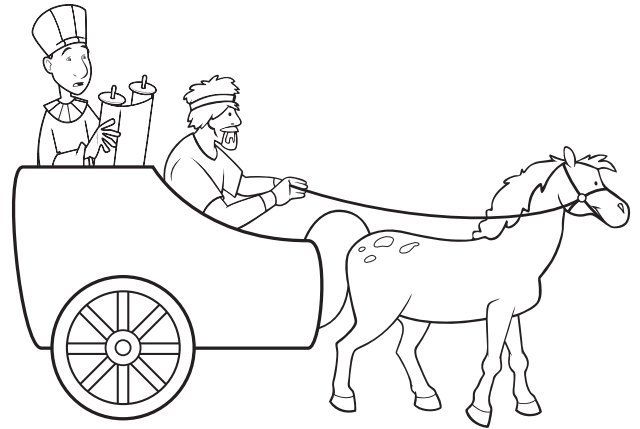
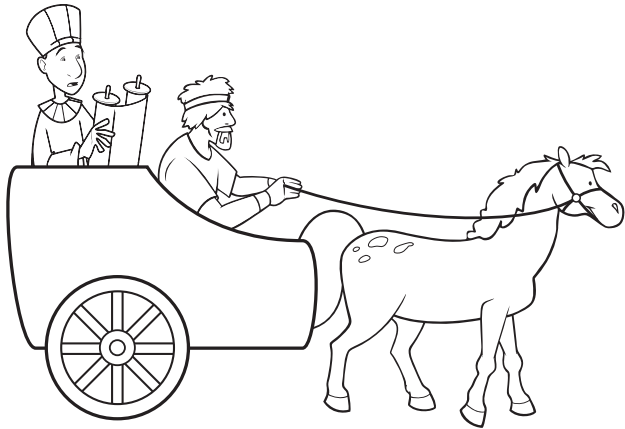
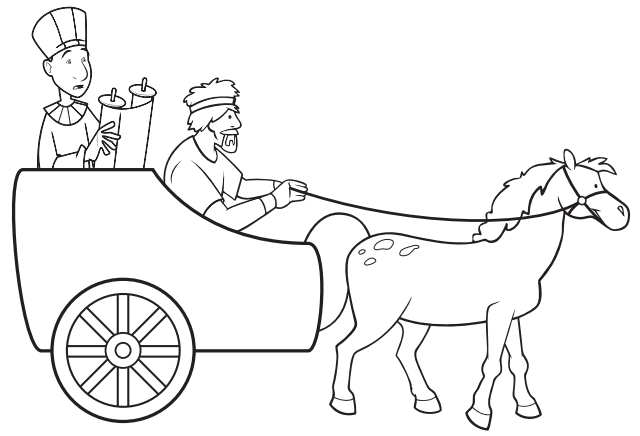
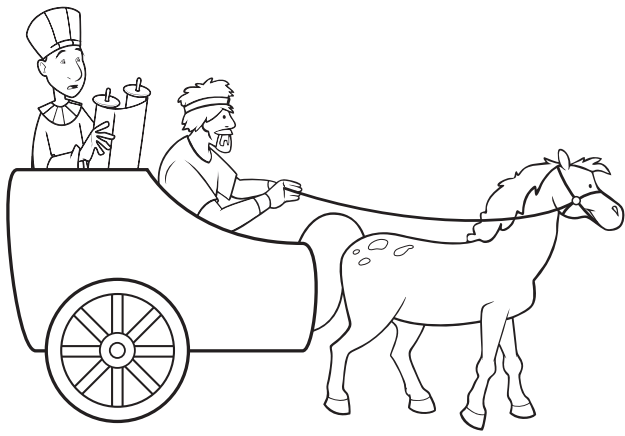


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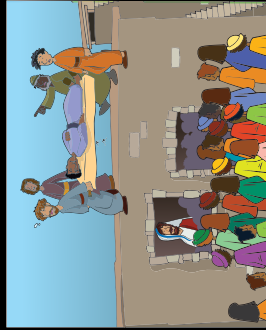
Instructions for Making Spoon Maracas

What You Need

- Plastic Easter eggs
- Popcorn kernels (or dry beans, rice or lentils)
- Plastic spoons
- Clear tape
- White duct tape or masking tape
- Permanent markers

1. Fill each egg about one third full with popcorn kernels. Close the egg and secure with clear tape.
2. Give each Cubbie an egg and two spoons. Show Cubbies how to position the egg between the two spoon cups.
3. Leaders will secure the egg between the spoons with a strip of wide white tape and also tape the ends of the spoon together. (If desired, the whole egg or the whole maraca can be covered with tape.)
4. Cubbies use markers to decorate the tape on the egg.

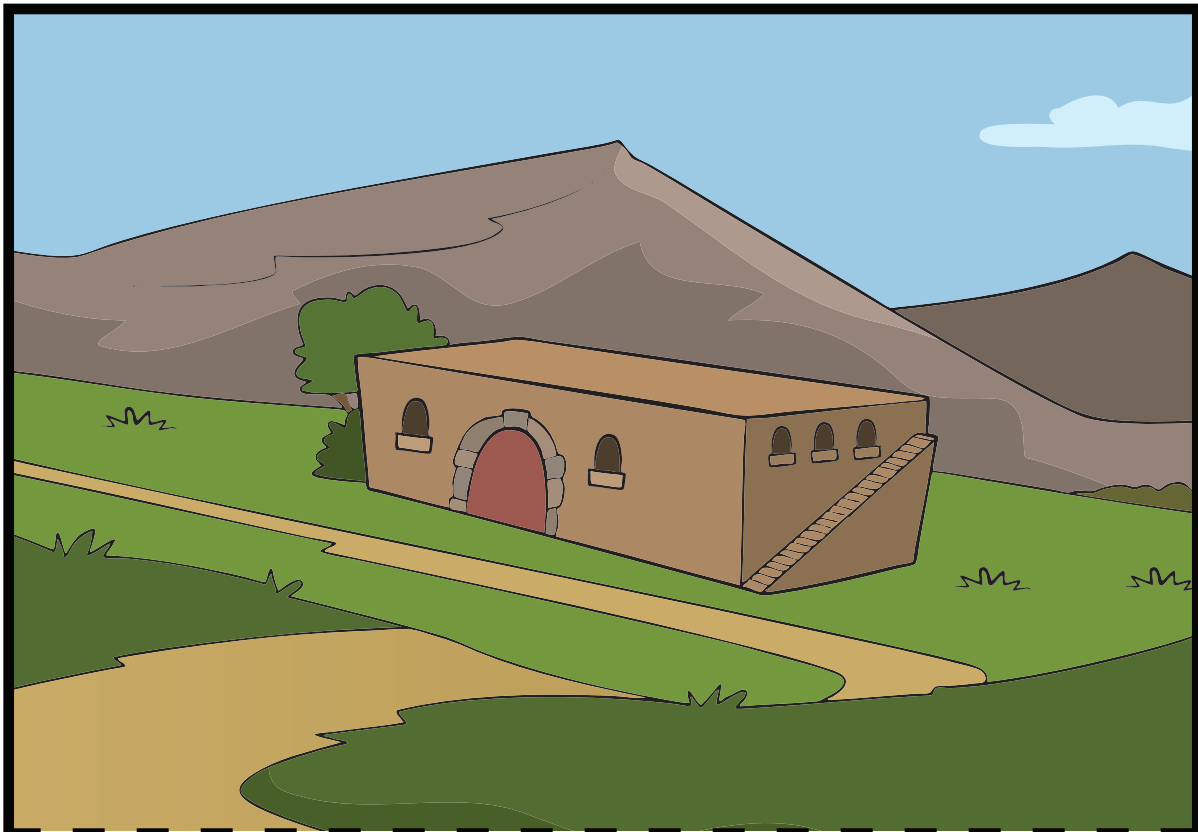
Assembly instructions

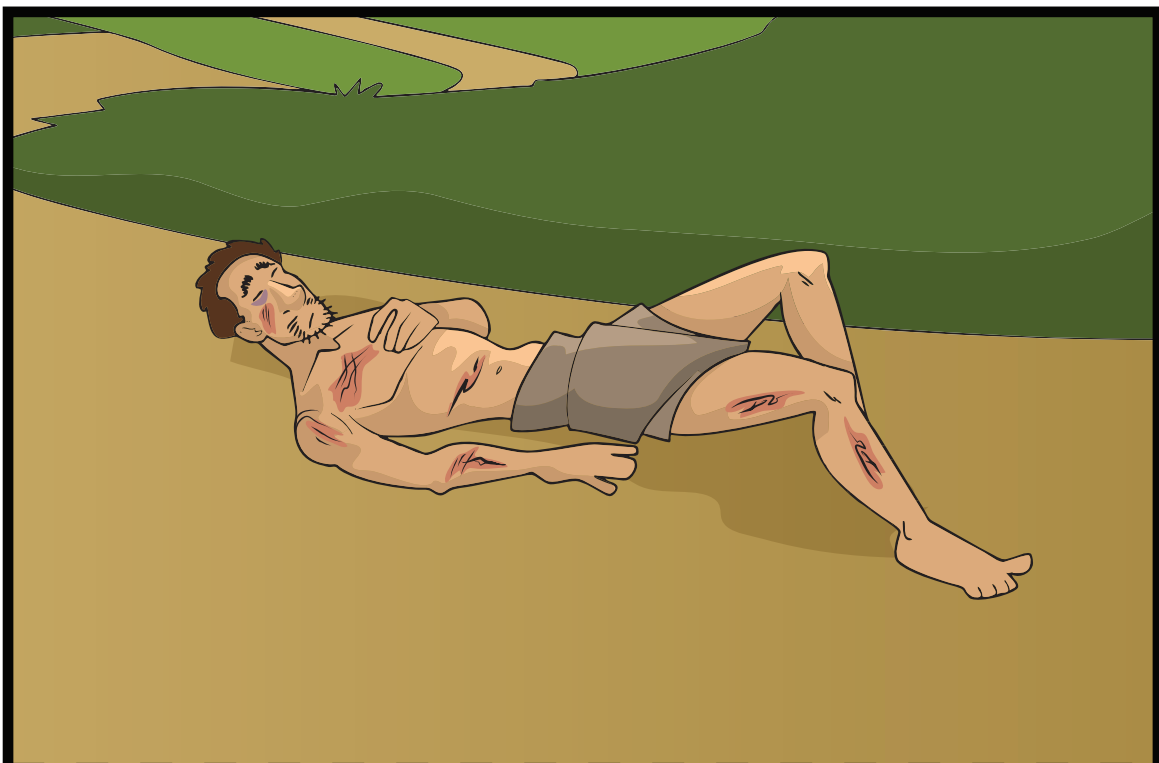

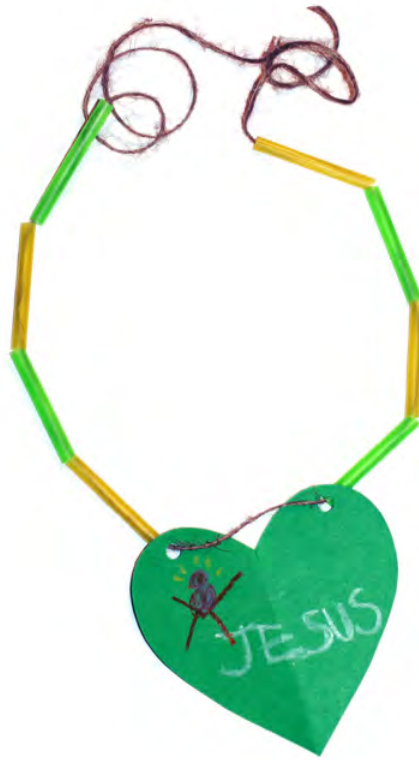

Instructions for Making Remember Jesus Necklaces

What You Need

- Card stock or foam sheet, cut into 3x3" (8x8 cm) pieces (could be square, circle or heart-shaped)
- Markers
- Hole punch
- Yarn
- Colorful drinking straws
- Pairs of child-sized scissors
- Optional — stickers of Jesus, hearts, crosses, etc.

1. Cubbies can decorate card stock pieces with stickers or by drawing pictures of things that remind them of Jesus. Leaders can model for older Cubbies how to write "Jesus."
2. When Cubbies are finished, leaders punch two holes at the top of each card stock piece to make a pendant. Then leaders thread a piece of yarn through the holes.
3. Cubbies cut straws into short sections to thread onto their necklaces.
4. Leaders tie yarn ends together in a knot when Cubbies are finished. Cubbies can wear necklaces to remind them of Jesus and what He did for them.
