

SERMON: LET ME TELL YOU WHY IT'S GOOD (A SIMPLE THANKSGIVING SERMON)

Psalm 92:1

It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High.

Introduction

Knowing “what is the truth” is important. Knowing “why is the truth” is just as important. There are two whys. There is the “why” of cause and there is the “why” of purpose. Let’s look briefly at these two whys as we explore our sermonic text. Let’s answer the question, “Why is it good to give thanks to God?”

(It Increases Faith And Hope For The Future.)

(It Encourages Generosity Toward Others.)

2. It Encourages Those Around You.

(Gratitude Is Contagious.)

(Grateful People Are Simply More Personable.)

(A Display Of Gratitude Is A Form Of Witnessing.)

(Others Will Come To Christ By Your Gratitude.)

3. God Deserves It, Just For Who He Is.

(It’s Just That Simple.)

(He Is God All By Himself.)

(He Does Not Need Our Praise, But He Deserves It.)

(We Need His Grace-He Deserves Our Gratitude.)

Closing Statements

We should thank God for providing the essentials of life. We should thank God in every situation of life, because all things work together for good to those who have answered the call to His purpose. Above all we should thank God for eternal life. Since God gives us unconditional love, we should reciprocate by giving Him unconditional gratitude and perpetual praise and worship. Give God Glory!
