

COVID-19 Safety

Here is a reminder of what's been installed and/or available:

- Sanctuary pews and chairs have been adapted for social distancing.
- Touchless paper towel dispensers available in first floor restrooms and kitchenette.
- Touchless soap/hand sanitizer dispensers available in first floor restrooms and kitchenette.
- Upper floor restrooms are being upgraded as time permits.
- Touchless sanitizer stands located in entries, lounge, west stair landing, sanctuary entrances.
- Spray bottles for isopropyl alcohol and disinfectant at entrances and in restrooms.
- Disinfectant and 98% isopropyl alcohol in gal. jugs in lounge and dining room.
- Dry surface wipes can be used with IPA or disinfectant.
- Plastic shielding, chain and hooks for main office countertop barrier installed.
- Foam core boards and tripods for displaying guidelines in place.
- Additional signage, procedure and log sheets have been placed throughout the church.

- Domestic indirect hot water tank and boiler controller replaced. Hot water now available.
- Planning for replacement of stained vinyl flooring for 1st floor men's restroom landing.
- Continuing to sort through collections of misc. stuff in basement.

- Snowblower winterized. Lawnmower ready for service.
