The Sunday School is the church organized to fulfill the Great Commission. Allan Taylor

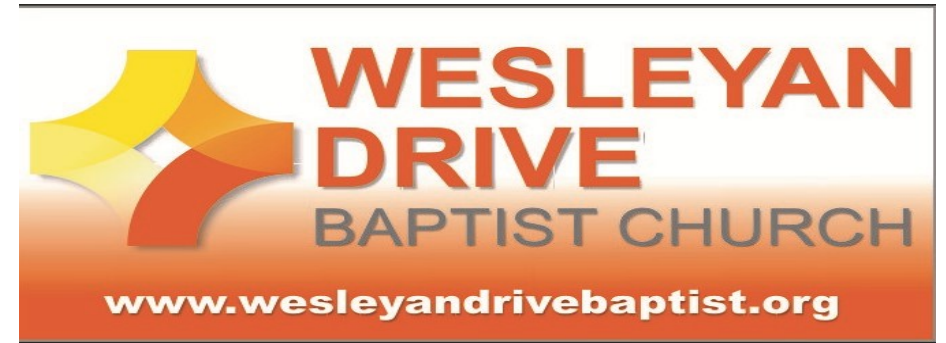
Alan Taylor in his book, "The Six Core Values of Sunday School", challenges the churches to take a closer look at the importance of Sunday school.

What then is the mission of the Sunday school? I believe many would say the mission is to "teach the Bible" or "fellowship together". While these are functions that take place in Sunday School, the main purpose of Sunday School is *to evangelize the lost*.

Notice in the quote up top by Allan Taylor, the Sunday School is the church ORGANIZED to fulfill the Great Commission. The old saying, failure to plan is planning to fail, is true even in Sunday School. Time is important and if you are like me, I don't like to have my time wasted. Without a organized plan for the worship service, we would end up wasting a lot of time before we realized it. The hour we have together in worship service is important and I believe we would be a poor steward of time not to have a plan. The same is true for Sunday School.

Charles Tidwell in his book, "The Educational Ministry Of A Church", defines six task the Sunday School should seek to accomplish.

1. Reach people for Bible study and fellowship
2. Teach the Bible
3. Lead people to Christ
4. Minister to people in need
5. Lead members to a more meaningful church membership
6. Support the work of the church
