# 1) Wildekrans Pinotage

9/14

2019 South Africa: Appearance: deep purple colour Nose: lifted nose evoking scents of black fruits, red fruits and spices Palate: full bodied rich and round with soft tannins, moderate acidity showing blackberries, blueberries, clove and cinnamon with a touch of oak.

## 2) Row Eleven Pinot Noir

7/12

2018 CA: Garnet red in color with a fruity & earthy nose. Flavors of jammy fruit led by bright cherry and raspberries with touches of mocha, vanilla and toasty oak on the finish; soft tannins and long finish.

#### 3) 642 Maremma Toscana Riserva

5/10

2018 Italy: On the nose, aromas of wild berry fruits, like blackberries and dried plum, yield to richer impressions of candied fruit and dark chocolate. Rich and full bodied in the mouth, this wine has tannins that are perfectly balanced and well-integrated. A lively acidity brightens the palate and the long-lived, delicious finish is silky and smooth.

# 4) Nicolas Patel Beaujolais - Villages

7/12

2017 France: Deep, garnet red. Delicate aromas of crushed fruits: strawberry, blackcurrant, cherry. Earthy, leather and pepper notes nicely accompany the intense fruit. A beautiful vinosity with a velvety structure. Fruity flavors, silky tannins, and nice acidity add a fresh touch to this easy-drinking wine.

# 5) EarthQuake Cabernet Sauvignon

10/15

2017 CA: A structured, full-bodied wine. Juicy, rich, bold, and filled to the brim with decadent black fruits. A hint of sweet vanilla and spice, this wine is smooth sailing but finishes with a punch of tobacco and toffee. Layered with notes of chocolate and savory.

# 6) McNab Sauvignon Blanc

5/10

2019 CA: Crisp and vibrant with aromas and flavors of melon, tropical fruit and spicy Asian pear. The finish is clean with a hint of citrus and minerality.

### 7) Casa Marrone Appassimento Organic

6/11

2016 Italy: This blend of organically grown Chardonnay, Trebbiano, Fiano and Falanghina offers aromas of ripe yellow apple, plum, dried apricot and hay on the nose. The palate is rich in fresh and dried fruit tones, but utterly dry, with a warming sensation on the finish.

# 8) Carol Shelton Coquille Blanc

8/13

2019 CA: Exotic nose of spicy pears and white peaches, almond paste/marzipan, a touch of honeysuckle perfume. Multi-dimensional with a wide range of aromatics, intriguing, almost mysterious! In the mouth it is crisply dry yet creamy and round and full-bodied, with nice almond paste on crisp-yet-juicy pear fruit.

### 9) House of Brown Chardonnay

7/12

2018 CA: Pineapple, starfruit, and guava with secondary notes of flowering star jasmine, orange blossoms, and traces of honeysuckle, lemon verbena, and meringue. Light, crisp, elegant, and juicy on the palate with a bright yet round mouthfeel. Made from sustainably grown wine grapes with small amounts of naturally occurring and added sulfites. Nothing else.

#### 10) La Baume Rosé

8/13

2020 France: Brilliant pink with clear violet shades with aromas of red fruits with a touch of red currant and spices. A very round and well-balanced wine.

### 11) Villa Jolanda Sparkling Moscato's Sweet

5/10

2017 Italy: **Flavors Available** - Peach , Pineapple, Passion Fruit, Strawberry and a regular flavored moscato (Blue)

#### 12) Red Electra Moscato Sweet Chilled

5/10

2018 Ca: Bright violet color. Candied aromas and flavors of pear fruit cup and wrapped cherry candies with a clean, bright, sweet light body and a smooth, short finish with no oak flavor. A fruity quaffer to serve on ice.

### 13) Bariano Prosecco Extra Dry

3/7

Italy: Light and refreshing with soft fruit notes of lemon and peach, this wine is perfect for any bubble lover.

# 14) deMossa Sparkling Fruit Cocktail

5/10

Spain "Bright hazy golden yellow color. Aromas of freshly sliced oranges and pez candies with a glycerous, vibrant, spritzy, fruity medium body and a smooth, relaxed orange chewy candies, hay, dried apricots and pineapples. A fresh and fun mimosa for easy brunch fun. Made with valencia oranges 11% alc vol . Add a shot of vodka for an extra \$3.00.

# 15) The Diver Sparkling Rosé

5/10

This gorgeous wine is made from a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. The Chardonnay from Monterey County adds a balanced acidity with notes of honeysuckle and kiwi. The Pinot Noir adds a beautiful color. Made in the Charmat method, the wine has about 2 bars of pressure creating a soft, Prosecco-like texture.
